Let's look at some examples!

To go (root verb)

ذَهَبَ

YOU DO NOT NEED TO KNOW WHY THE CONJUGATIONS ARE LIKE THIS FOR THE SAKE OF THIS SHORT COURSE

I go

أَذْهَبُ

You (masc.) go

تَذْهَبُ

You (fem.) go

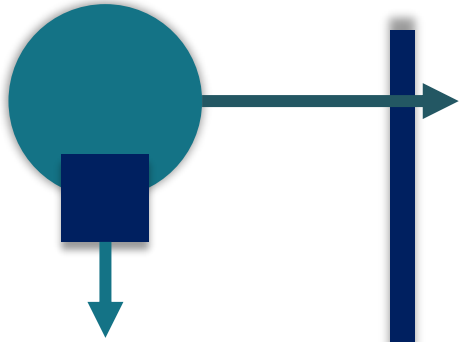
تَذْهَبِينَ

You (plural) go

تَذْهَبُونَ

We go

نَذْهَبُ



Past tense

Full phrase	Transliteration	Past conjugation for "TO GO"	Transliteration	Pronoun
أَنَا ذَهَبْتُ I went	Zahabtu	ذَهَبْتُ I went	Ana	أَنَا I
نَحْنُ ذَهَبْنَا We went	Zahabna	ذَهَبْنَا We went	Nahnu	نَحْنُ We
أَنْتَ ذَهَبْتَ You (masc.) went	Zahabta	ذَهَبْتَ You went (masc.)	Anta	أَنْتَ You (masc.)
أَنْتِ ذَهَبْتِ You (fem.) went	Zahabti	ذَهَبْتِ You went (fem.)	Anti	أَنْتِ You (fem.)
أَنْتُمْ ذَهَبْتُمْ You (plural) went	Zahabtum	ذَهَبْتُمْ You went (plural)	Antum	أَنْتُمْ You (plural)

Verbs – “doing words”

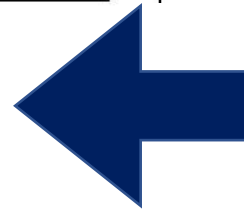

To worship	عَبَدَ	To write	كَتَبَ
To exit	خَرَجَ	To prostrate	سَجَدَ
To do	فَعَلَ	To bow down	رَكَعَ
To return	رَجَعَ	To thank	شَكَرَ
To remember	ذَكَرَ	To help	نَصَرَ
