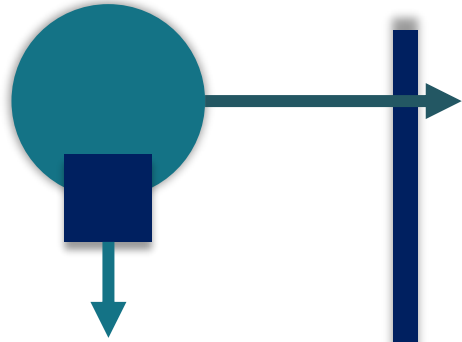

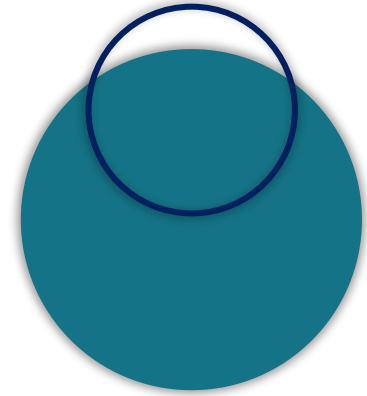

Singular pronouns

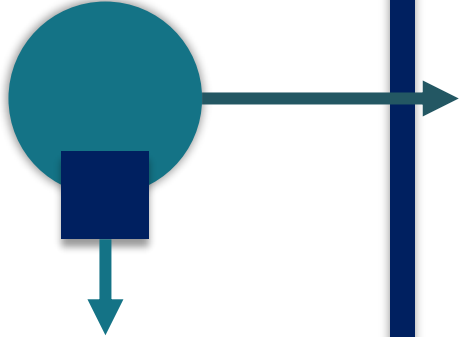
What is a pronoun?

| English | Transliteration | Arabic |
|-----------------|-----------------|--------|
| I | Ana | أَنَا |
| You (masculine) | Anta | أَنْتَ |
| You (feminine) | Anti | أَنْتِ |
| He | Huwa | هُوَ |
| She | He-ya | هِيَ |

|--------------|-----------------|-------------------|
| Good morning | Sabaah-ul-Khair | صَبَاحُ الْخَيْرِ |
| Good evening | Masaa-ul-Khair | مَسَاءُ الْخَيْرِ |
| Sorry | Aasif | آسِفٌ |
| Please | Min fadhlik | مِنْ فَضْلِكَ |
| Thank you | Shukrann | شُكْرًا |

Conversation

We are going to have a conversation now!

The conversation should flow as following:

1. Greeting (try and add “good evening”)
2. How are you? (try and say “thank you”)
3. What is your name? (use “and you?”)
4. Where are you from?
5. How old are you?

- If you get stuck, or cannot understand what the other person has said, say “sorry” in Arabic.
- Try and use only Arabic
- While waiting to get picked, prepare your conversation and practice by shadowing the teacher or practicing with a family member.
