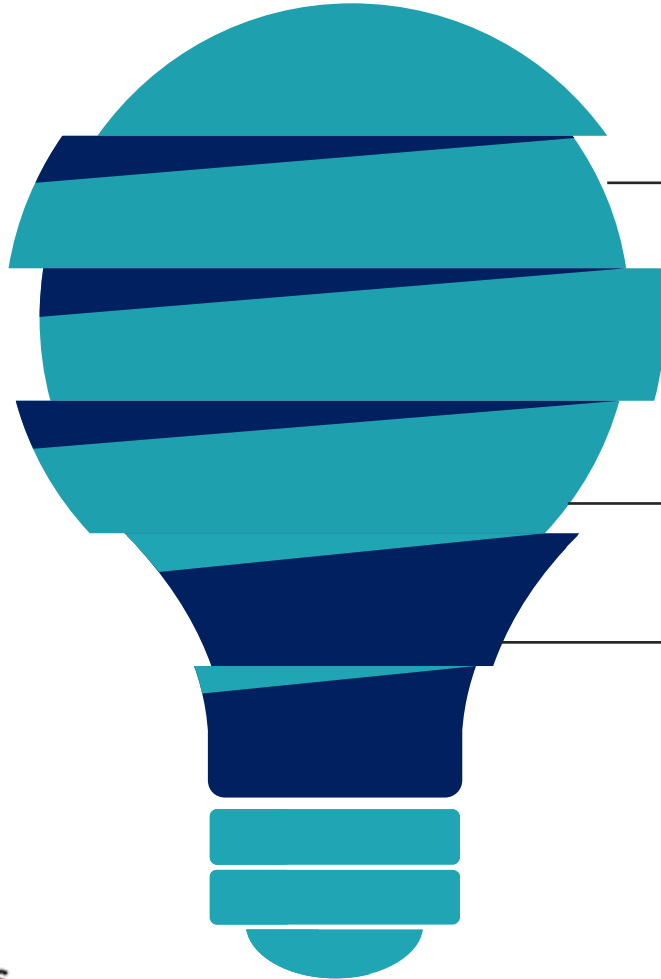

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# Hadith

إِنَّمَا الْأَعْمَالُ بِالنِّيَّاتِ

*Inna mal a'maalu binniyyaat*

Deeds are judged by motives

Allah the Almighty rewards a person's actions based upon their intentions. For example if someone migrates for the sake of Allah, then Allah will reward him. However if someone migrates for their own ulterior motives (such as work or marriage etc.) then Allah will not reward such a person.

Some acts are done by sheer force of habit, some in imitation of other people, and some for show and advertisement. But our Master, the Holy Prophet (saw), says that all these deeds carry no weight in the balance of Allah and that correct deeds are the ones done with a true intention and a sincere mind.

For example, some people fast because the people around them do so, or some people perform Hajj so they can be known as pious. A false act, however virtuous it may appear to be, cannot be deserving of any reward from Allah.

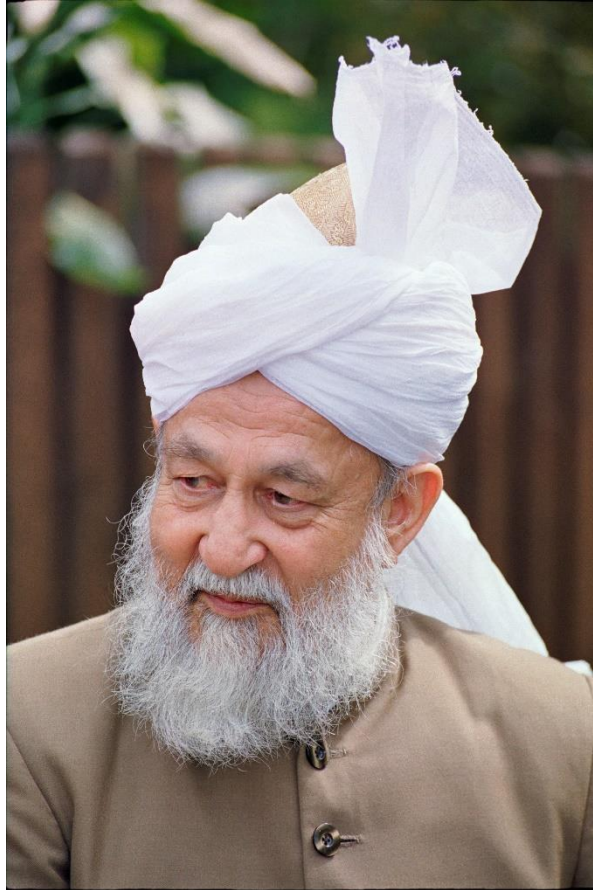

*“It is not only my mother who loves Huzoor – I also love him very much!”*

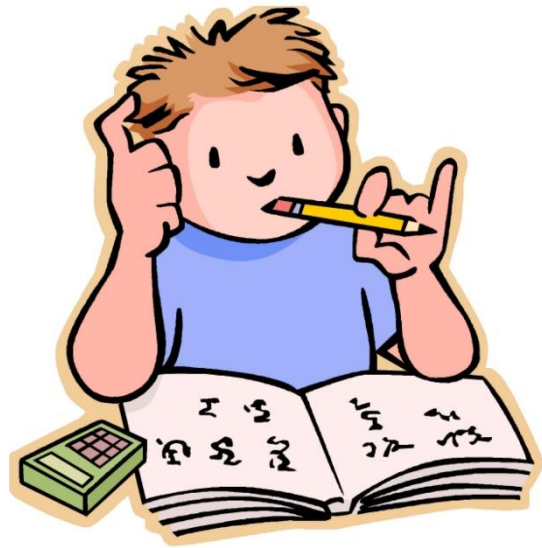
