# RULES FOR TILAWAT

- Participants can recite any of the selected portions from the syllabus.
- A recitation from outside the syllabus will get a total mark of zero.
- Marks will be deducted if the Tifl forgets to recite Ta'awwuz or Tasmiyya.
- There will be no additional marks for reciting from memory.
- Judges reserve the right to stop a participant at any point.
- Marks will be awarded for:
  - (a) Pronunciation – *Makharij*
  - (b) Tajweed
  - (c) Melody – *Lehan*

- Reading a nazm from outside the syllabus will get a total mark of zero.
- Judges reserve the right to stop a participant at any point.
- Marks will be awarded for:
  - (a) Pronunciation
  - (b) Quality of Voice – *Husne Adaige*
  - (c) Melody – *Lehan*

  - (b) Quality of Delivery – Husne Adaige
  - (c) Tune - Lehan

# **ENGLISH PREPARED SPEECH**

# RULES FOR ENGLISH PREPARED SPEECH

- The speech must be delivered in English language.
- Any speech delivered on a topic from outside the syllabus will get a total mark of zero.
- The speech should be no longer than 1 minute and 30 seconds.
- The speech can contain Arabic verses, but Urdu references and couplets are not allowed.
- There will be no additional marks for reciting from memory.
- Judges reserve the right to stop a participant at any point.
- Marks will be awarded for:
  - (a) Pronunciation
  - (b) Content
  - (c) Delivery – *Way of Expression*

- There will be no additional marks for reciting from memory.
- Judges reserve the right to stop a participant at any point.
- Marks will be awarded for:
  - (a) Pronunciation
  - (b) Content
  - (c) Delivery – *Way of Expression*

  - (d) Speech Structure

# **HIFZ-E-AHADITH**

# RULES FOR HIFZ-E-AHADITH

- This competition is not for positions.
- The judge reserves the right to ask a participant any Hadith and its translation from the Syllabus.
- A participant may take up to 10 seconds before answering.
- Marks will be awarded for:
  - (a) Pronunciation
  - (b) Accuracy
  - (c) Fluency

  - (a) Pronunciation
  - (b) Accuracy
  - (c) Fluency

# RULES FOR ESSAY WRITING COMPETITION

- The essay should be written in English language.
- The essay must be written on one of the topics given in the syllabus. Other topics will not be marked.
- Atfal in Amanat group should write an essay of 400 to 500 words.
- Atfal in Dianat group should write an essay of 500 to 600 words.
- Atfal in Sadaqat or Shaja'at groups should write an essay of 600 to 700 words.
- Separate positions will be finalised for each age group.
- Write your full name, date of birth, Qiadat, AIMS ID and email address clearly at the start of the essay.
- Any grammar, spelling and punctuation errors will be penalized.
- All references should be properly cited. For example, if an extract is taken from a book then the name of the book and the relevant page number should be stated.
- Parents are encouraged to proofread the essay and suggest improvements, but the main essay should be written by the Tifl himself.
- The deadline for submitting the essay is two weeks prior to the National Ijtema.

# RULES FOR QUIZ COMPETITION

  - Khutbat-e-Imam (4 Sermons of Huzoor [aba])\*\*
  - Deeni Maloomat (religious knowledge)
  - General Knowledge

# WHAT IS THE YOUNG MUAVINEEN CHAMPIONSHIP?

- The Young Muavineen Championship was introduced for the first time at National Ijtema 2021.
