- There will be no additional marks for reciting from memory.
- Judges reserve the right to stop a participant at any point.
- Marks will be awarded for:
  - (a) Structure of Argument
  - (b) Content
  - (c) Delivery Way of Expression

### RULES FOR PREPARED SPEECH URDU

- The speech must be delivered in Urdu language.
- Any speech delivered on a topic from outside the syllabus will get a total mark of zero.
- Marks will be deducted if a speech is longer that 1 minute 30 seconds.
- The speech can contain Arabic verses, but English references and couplets are not allowed.
- There will be no additional marks for reciting from memory.
- Judges reserve the right to stop a participant at any point.
- Marks will be awarded for:
  - (a) Structure of Argument
  - (b) Content
  - (c) Delivery Way of Expression

- The judge reserves the right to ask a participant any portion from the Syllabus.
- A participant may take up to 10 seconds before starting their answer.
- Positions will be awarded according to overall score.

  - The judge will only give the reference to the portion, for example "Recite Surah Al-Ikhlas" or "Recite Surah Al-Bakarah verse 1 till 7".
  - Giving the first few words of Arabic such as "Recite تُّلُ هُوَاللَّهُ" will be considered as a hint and will result in mark deduction.

  - The judge will only ask the Hadith by giving the initial few words of the Arabic or translation and never ask the Hadith by its number. For example, a Tifl may be asked to "Recite the Hadith that starts with غَيْرُ الزَّادِ" or "Recite Hadith with the translation The best provision for the journey"
- A participant may take up to 10 seconds before answering.
- Marks will be awarded for:
  - (a) Pronunciation and accuracy of the Arabic
  - (b) Accuracy of the translation
