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SYLLABUS

RULES

- This is an open team competition which will only be held at National Ijtema.
- The quiz competition will be held separately for each age group.
- Each team will consist of 3 Atfal from one age group.
- **If you would like to take part, contact your Regional Nazim Atfal.**
- Teams should be submitted by Regional Nazimeen by the **14th of September.**
- There will be multiple rounds, including:
 - Salat
 - Ahadith
 - Religious Knowledge
 - General Knowledge
- Each team will be provided with a pen and a paper for each round and will answer the same questions simultaneously.
- The quiz master's decision will be final.

ROUND 1 (SALAAT ROUND)

- In this round, teams will be asked a variety of questions about Salaat.
- The following is the syllabus for each age group:

Dianat (7-9):

- Full Arabic of Salaat

Sadaqat (10-12):

- Full Arabic of Salaat
- Translation up to and including ruku'

Shujaat (13-15):

- Full Arabic of Salaat
- Full translation

ROUND 2 (HADITH ROUND)

- In this round, teams will be asked a variety of questions about Hadith (listed below).
- The following is the syllabus for each age group:

Dianat (7-9):

- Hadith No. 1-10

Sadaqat (10-12):

- Hadith No. 1-20

Shujaat (13-15):

- Hadith No. 1-40

- Participants will need to know both the Arabic and the translation of the Ahadith.

Hadith No. 1
خَيْرُ الزَّادِ التَّقْوَى
The best provision for the journey to the hereafter is righteousness.
Khair-uz-zadit-taqwa

Hadith No. 2
الْغِنَى غِنَى النَّفْسِ
True wealth is wealth of the heart.
Al ghinaa ghinan-nafs

Hadith No. 3
إِنَّمَا الْأَعْمَالُ بِالنِّيَّاتِ
Deeds are judged by motives.
Inna-mal a'maalu bin-niyyaat

Hadith No. 4
سَبَابُ الْمُسْلِمِ فُسُوقٌ
Abuse by (or of) a Muslim is an evil.
Sibaab-ul-muslimi fusooq

HIFZ-E-AHADITH

Hadith No. 5
مَنْ لَا يَرْحَمُ لَا يُرْحَمُ
The one who doesn't show mercy will not be shown mercy.
Mal-la yarham, laa yurham

Hadith No. 6
خَيْرُكُمْ مَنْ تَعَلَّمَ الْقُرْآنَ وَعَلَّمَهُ
The best among you is the one who learns the Quran and teaches it to others.
Khairu-kum man ta'allamal-qur'aana wa 'allamahu

Hadith No. 7
الْحَيَاءُ خَيْرٌ كُلُّهُ
Modesty is the best virtue.
Al-hayaa'u khairun kulluhu

Hadith No. 8
السَّعِيدُ مَنْ وَعَظَ بِغَيْرِهِ
A pious person learns from others (other's mistakes).
As-sa'eedu manw-wu'iza bi-ghairihi

Hadith No. 9
لَيْسَ الْخَبْرُ كَالْمُعَايَنَةِ
Hearing is not like seeing.
Laysal-khabaru kal-mu'ayana

Hadith No. 10
طَلَبُ الْعِلْمِ فَرِيضَةٌ عَلَى كُلِّ مُسْلِمٍ وَمُسْلِمَةٍ
Acquisition of knowledge is obligatory upon every Muslim man and woman.
Talabul `ilmi faridatun `ala kulli muslimin wa muslimah

Hadith No. 11
مَا قَلَّ وَكَفَى خَيْرٌ مِّمَّا كَثُرَ وَآلَهُ
A little that suffices one's need is better than plenty that makes him forgetful (of Allah).
Ma qalla wakafa khairum-mimma kathura wa `alha

Hadith No. 12
مَنْ قُتِلَ دُونَ مَالِهِ فَهُوَ شَهِيدٌ
The one who dies protecting their property is a martyr (Shaheed).
Man qu-ti-la doona maa-li-hi fa-huwa sha-heed

Hadith No. 13
مَا هَلَكَ إِمْرَءٌ عَرَفَ قَدْرَهُ
He who knows his own worth, would never perish.
Ma halaka imra-un `arafa qadrah

Hadith No. 14
الْمُسْلِمُ مِرْآةُ الْمُسْلِمِ
A Muslim is a mirror of another Muslim.
Al-muslimu mir'aa-tul muslim

Hadith No. 15
الْمُسْتَشَارُ مُؤْتَمَنٌ
A person who is consulted becomes a trustee.
Al musta-shaa-ru mu'-taman

Hadith No. 16
الْمَجَالِسُ بِالْأَمَانَةِ
All get-togethers (of people) are based on (their mutual) trust.
Al majaa-lisu bil-amaa-na

Hadith No. 17
الْبِرُّ مَعَ مَنْ أَحَبَّ
A person is with the one who he loves.
Al mar'u ma'a man ahabba

Hadith No. 18
الْبَلَاءُ مُؤَكَّلٌ بِاللِّسَانِ
Talking without thinking can result in trouble.
Al ba-laa'u mu-akka-lun bil-man-taq

Hadith No. 19
خَيْرُ الْأُمُورِ أَوْسَطُهَا
Best work is one that is done in moderation.
Khairul umoori aw-satu-ha

Hadith No. 20
الدَّالُّ عَلَى الْخَيْرِ كَفَاعِلِهِ
The one who urges others to do good, gets the reward like a doer.
Ad-daal-lu alal khairi ka faa-ili-hi

Hadith No. 21
عِدَّةُ الْمُؤْمِنِ كَأَخْذِ الْكَفِّ
The promise of a believer is as certain as a thing in the hand.
Ida-tul mu'mini ka akh-dhil-kaff

Hadith No. 22
لَيْسَ مِنَّا مَنْ غَشَّاهَا
The one who deceives us is not from us.
Laisa minna man ghashha-na

Hadith No. 23
سَيِّدُ الْقَوْمِ خَادِمُهُمْ
The chief of the people is one who serves them.
Sayyi-dul qawmi khaa-di-mu-hum

Hadith No. 24
لَا يَشْكُرُ اللَّهَ مَنْ لَا يَشْكُرُ النَّاسَ
One who is not thankful to people is not thankful to Allah.
Laa yash-kur-ullah-a ma-lla yash-kur-un naas

HIFZ-E-AHADITH

Hadith No. 25
اَلْيَدُ الْعُلْيَا خَيْرٌ مِّنْ اَلْيَدِ السُّفْلَى
The upper hand is better than the lower hand. (The hand that gives is better than the hand that receives).
Al ya-dul ul-yaa khai-rum min-al yad-is sufflaa
Hadith No. 26
اَلتَّائِبُ مِنَ الذَّنْبِ كَمَنْ لَا ذَنْبَ لَهُ
A person who sincerely repents for their sins becomes like one who has never sinned.
At-taa-i-bu mina-dhham-bi ka-man laa dham-ba lah
Hadith No. 27
اِذَا جَاءَكُمْ كَرِيمٌ قَوْمٍ فَآكِرِ مُوَهُ
When some respected person of another nation visits you give respect to them.
Idha jaa-a-kum kareem-u qaw-min fa-akri-mooh
Hadith No. 28
اَلْيَمِينُ الْفَاجِرَةُ تَدْعُ الدِّيَارَ بَلَاقِعَ
False vouch (swear) makes houses deserted.
Al-ya-meen-ul faa-ji-ra-tu ta-da-ud-diyaa-ra ba-laa-qi'

HIFZ-E-AHADITH

Hadith No. 29
اتَّقُوا النَّارَ وَلَوْ بِشِقِّ تَمْرَةٍ
Save yourself from hell, even if it by giving a fragment of a date (as sadaqah).
Itta-qun naara wa law bi-shiqqi tam-ra-tin

Hadith No. 30
الدُّنْيَا سِجْنٌ لِلْمُؤْمِنِ وَجَنَّةٌ لِلْكَافِرِ
This world is a prison for the righteous believer and heaven for a non-believer.
Ad-dunya sij-nul-lil mu'-mini wa janna-tun lil-kaafir

Hadith No. 31
الرَّاجِعُ فِي هِبَتِهِ كَالرَّاجِعِ فِي قَيْهِ
The man who takes back his gift is like the one who licks his own vomit.
Ar-raa-ji-u fee hiba-tihi kar-raa-ji-'i fee qay-ih

Hadith No. 32
لَا يَحِلُّ لِمُؤْمِنٍ أَنْ يَهْجُرَ أَخَاهُ فَوْقَ ثَلَاثَةِ أَيَّامٍ
It is not permissible for a Muslim to sever relations with another Muslim brother for more than three days.
Laa yahil-lu li mu'mi-nin ay-yah-jura akhaa-hu faw-qa thalaa-tha-ti ay-yaam

HIFZ-E-AHADITH

Hadith No. 33
إِيَّاكُمْ وَالظَّنَّ فَإِنَّ الظَّنَّ أَكْذَبُ الْحَدِيثِ
Avoid suspicion because suspicion is the worst form of falsehood.
Iyyaakum waz zanna fa ‘inna zzanna akdhabul hadith

Hadith No. 34
أَفْشُوا السَّلَامَ بَيْنَكُمْ
Spread greetings of peace between each other.
Afshus-salaa-ma bay-na-kum

Hadith No. 35
الطُّهُورُ شَطْرُ الْإِيمَانِ
Cleanliness is a part of faith.
At-tu-hoo-ru shat-rul ee-maan

Hadith No. 36
إِيَّاكُمْ وَالْحَسَدَ فَإِنَّ الْحَسَدَ يَأْكُلُ الْحَسَنَاتِ
Beware of jealousy, jealousy consumes virtue.
Iyaa-kum wal hasada fa-innal hasada ya’kul-ul hasa-naat

HIFZ-E-AHADITH

Hadith No. 37
الْجَنَّةُ تَحْتَ أَقْدَامِ الْأُمَّهَاتِ
Paradise lies under the feet of the mother.
Al-janna-tu tah-ta aq-daam-il umma-haat

Hadith No. 38
كُلْ بِيَمِينِكَ وَمِمَّا يَلِيكَ
Eat with your right hand and eat from in front of you.
Kul bi ya-mee-ni-ka wa mim-maa ya-leek

Hadith No. 39
لَا يَدْخُلُ الْجَنَّةَ قَاطِعٌ
The one who cuts off ties of friendship/kinship will not enter paradise.
La yadkhulul jannata qati'

Hadith No. 40
لَا يُؤْمِنُ أَحَدُكُمْ حَتَّى يُحِبَّ لِأَخِيهِ مَا يُحِبُّ لِنَفْسِهِ
None amongst you can be a true believer unless he likes for his brother what he like for himself.
La yuminu ahadukum hatta yuhibba li' akhlihi ma yuhibba li nafsih

ROUND 3 (RELIGIOUS KNOWLEDGE)

- In this round, teams will be asked a variety of questions about general religious knowledge
- The questions from this round will mainly be based on the **Waqfe Nau syllabus** for each each age group

Sample question:

Q: What are the 5 pillars of Islam?

A: Kalima, Salat, Zakaat, Fasting, Hajj

ROUND 4 (GENERAL KNOWLEDGE)

- In this round, teams will be asked a variety of questions about general knowledge (e.g. geography, science, current affairs, history etc.)

Sample question:

Q: What is the capital city of Australia?

- a. Sydney
- b. Melbourne
- c. Canberra
- d. Perth
