(Holy Qur'an 62:10)*

In many Muslim countries, people take a break from work or close their shops on Fridays so that they can perform the Friday Prayer. This is because Allah Ta'ala commands us to do so in this verse.

The Friday Sermon, also called the Khutbah, is a very special time for us to learn wisdom and receive guidance.
