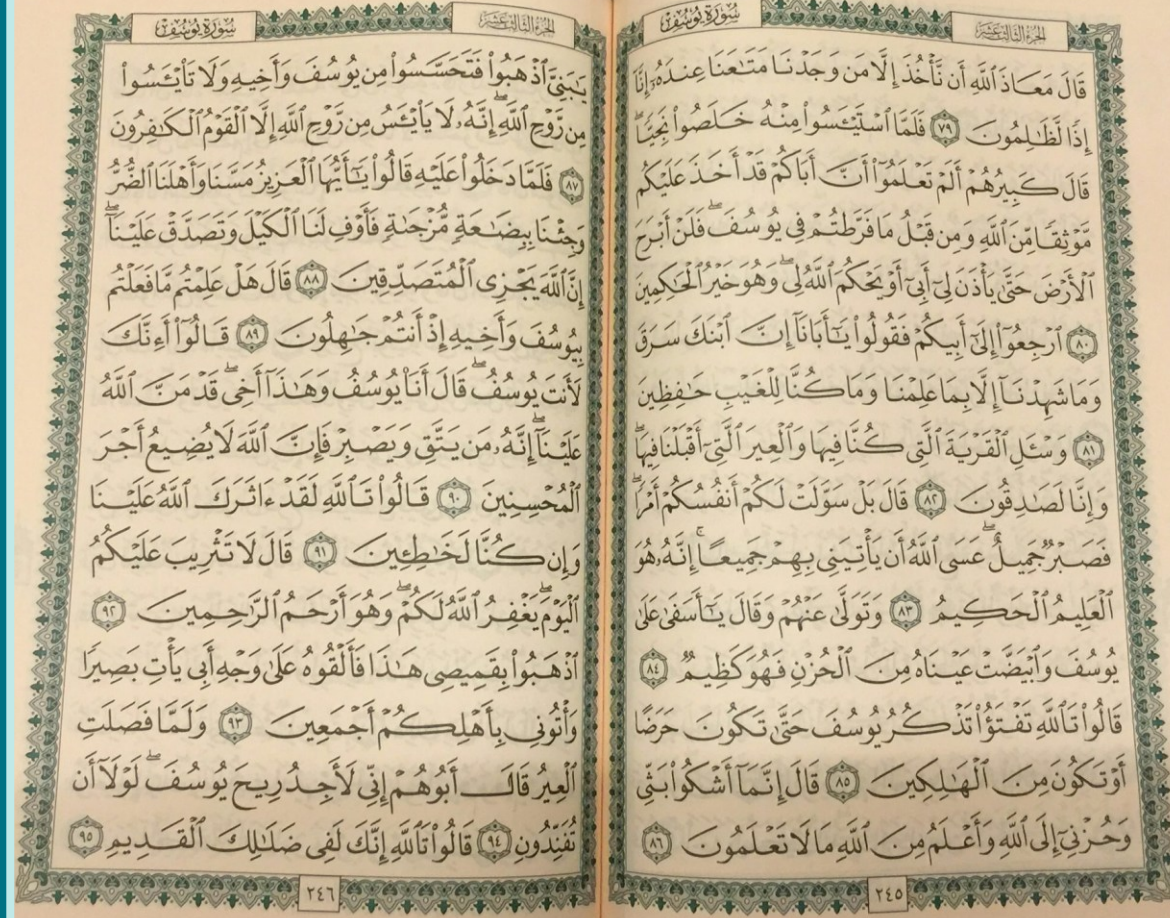

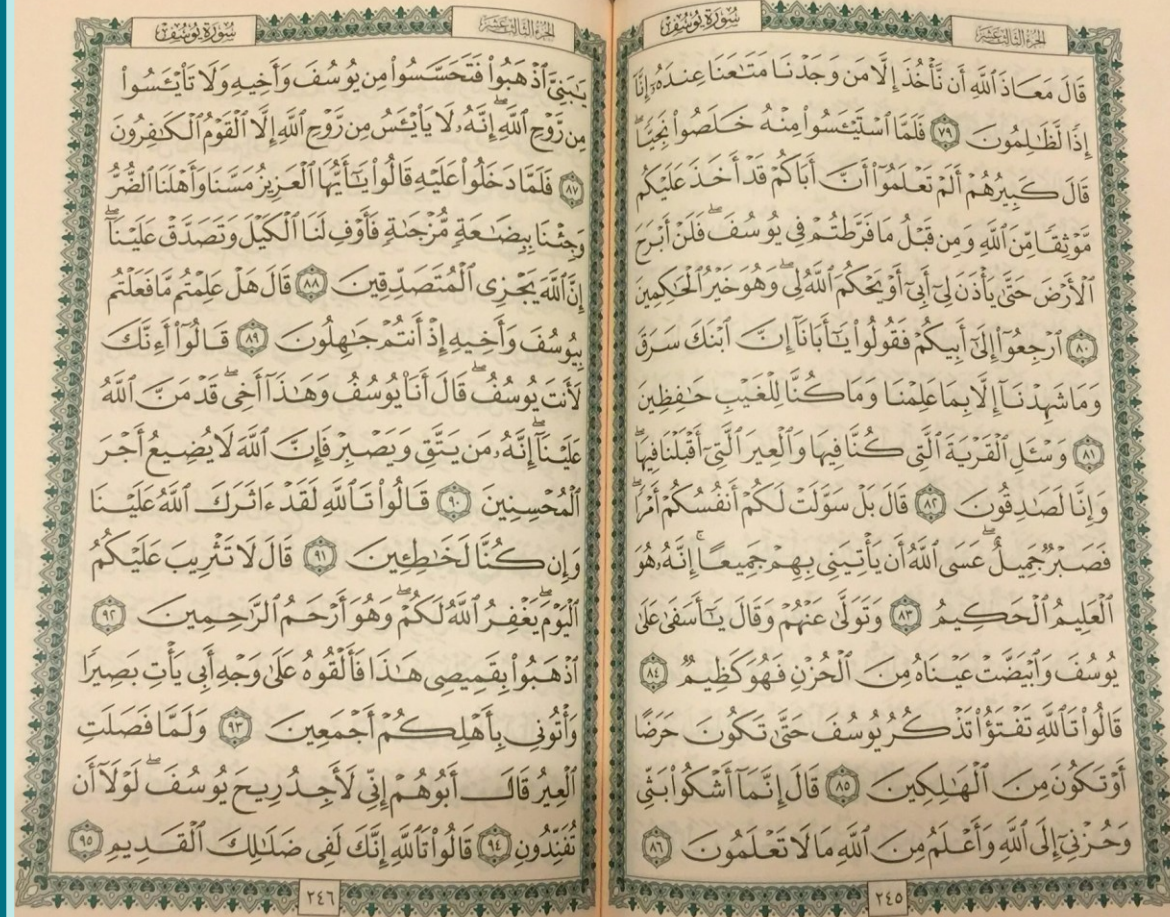

فَيَقُولُونَ أَلَمْ تُبَيِّضْ وُجُوهَنَا أَلَمْ تُدْخِلْنَا الْجَنَّةَ وَتُنْجِنَا مِنَ النَّارِ - قَالَ -  
فَيَكْشِفُ الْحِجَابَ فَمَا أُعْطُوا شَيْئًا أَحَبَّ إِلَيْهِمْ مِنَ النَّظَرِ إِلَى رَبِّهِمْ عَزَّ وَجَلَّ

**Idhā dakhala ahlu al-jannati al-jannah – qāla – yaqūlu Allāhu tabāraka wa ta‘ālā:  
turīdūna shay’an azīdukum? fa-yaqūlūna: alam tubayyiḍ wujūhanā? alam

# HADITH

(sayings of the Holy Prophet Muhammad<sup>sas</sup>)

## Translation:

**Narrated by Hadrat Suhaib<sup>ra</sup>:**

“When those deserving of Paradise would enter Paradise, the Blessed and the Exalted would ask: Do you wish Me to give you anything more? They would say: Hast Thou not brightened our faces? Hast Thou not made us enter Paradise and saved us from Fire? He (the narrator) said: He (God) would lift the veil, and of things given to them nothing would be dearer to them than the sight of their Lord, the Mighty and the Glorious.”

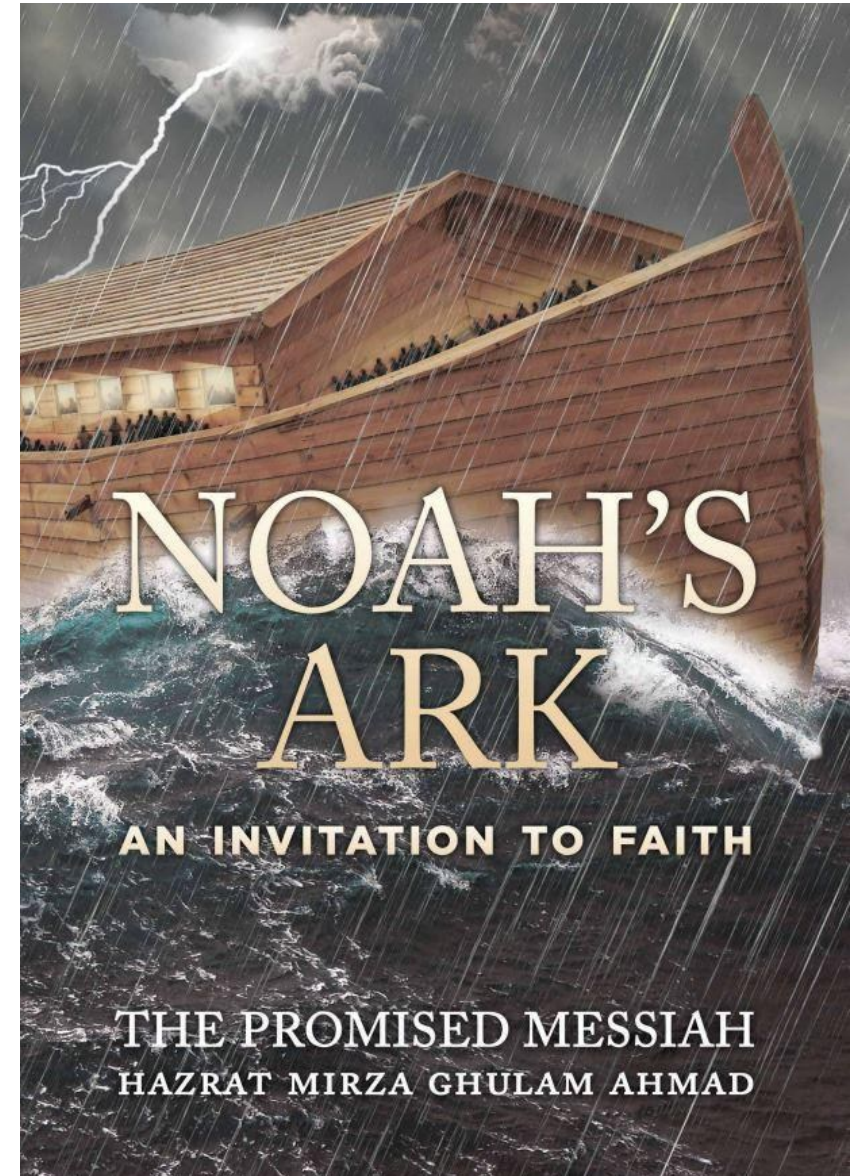
Our Paradise Lies

The Promised Messiah<sup>as</sup> states:

*“Our paradise lies in our God. Our highest delight is in our God for we have seen Him and found every beauty in Him. This wealth is worth procuring though one might have to lay down one’s life to procure it. This ruby is worth purchasing though one may have to lose oneself to acquire it. O ye, who are deprived! Hasten to this fountain as it will satiate you. It is this fountain of life that will save you. What am I to do? How shall I impress the hearts with this good news? What sort of a drum am I to beat in the streets in order to make the announcement that this is your God, so that people might hear?”*

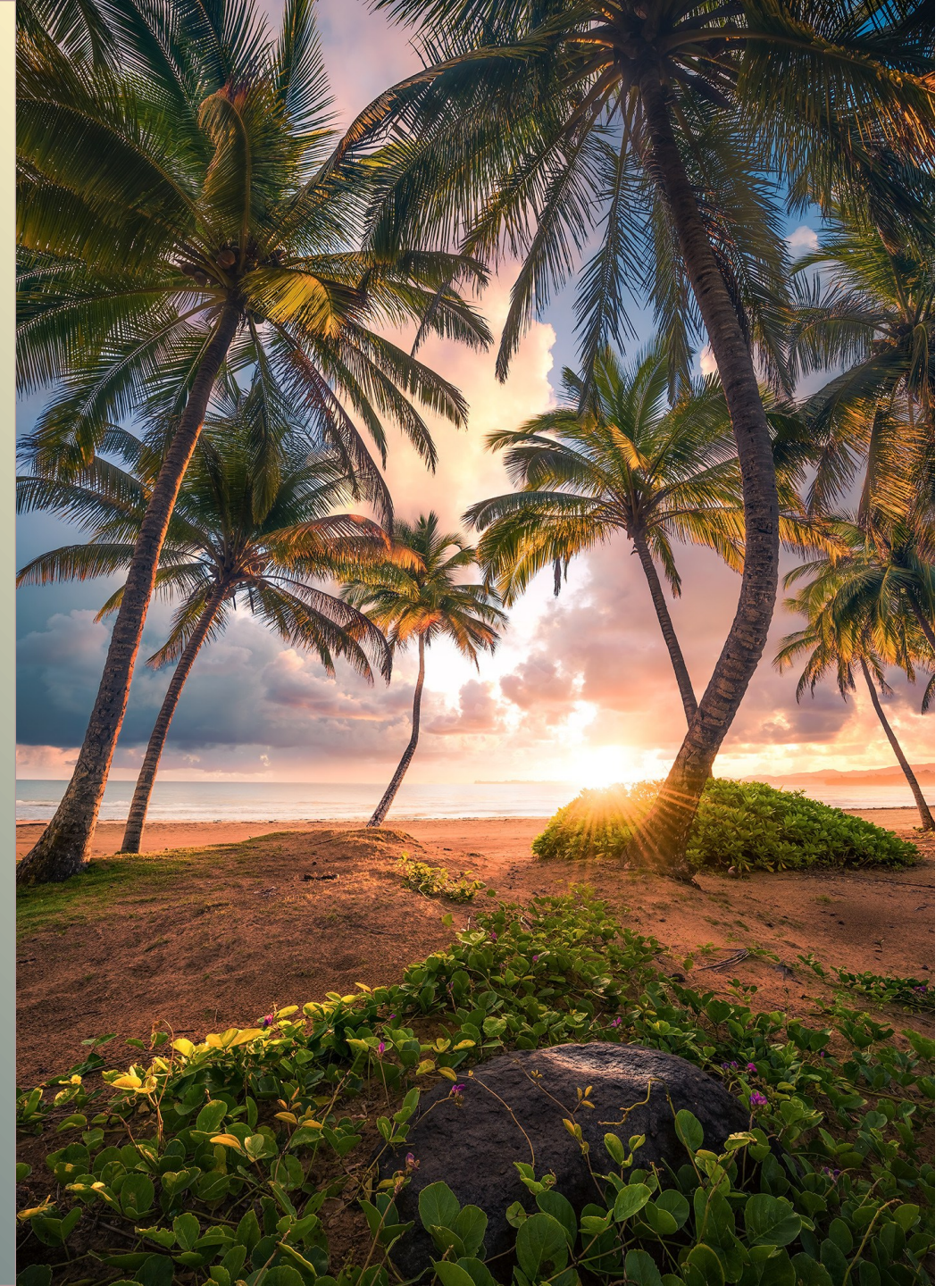

# What does the phrase “OUR PARADISE LIES IN OUR GOD” mean in this context?

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- The phrase means that to obtain paradise, we need to obtain God.
- This means that our relationship and connection with Allah the Almighty will depend on whether we attain paradise in the afterlife.
- Another meaning of this is that our “happiness” also lies in our God.



# How can we “SEE AND FIND BEAUTY IN GOD ALMIGHTY”?

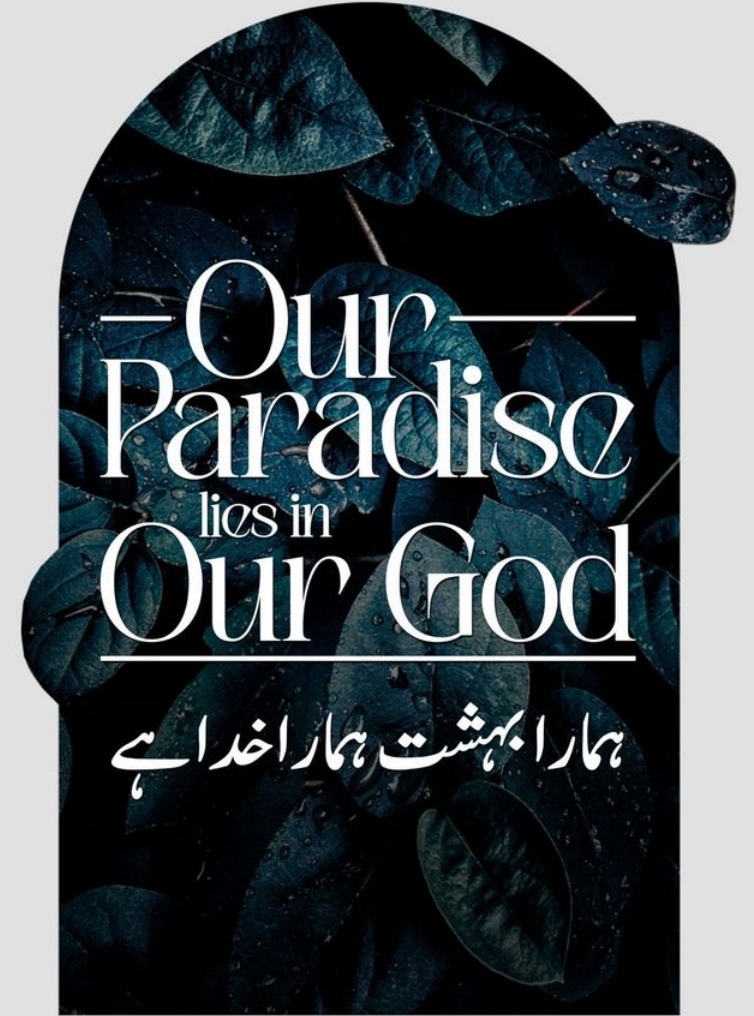
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- We cannot physically see God Almighty with our eyes.
- We should take the metaphorical meaning that through prayers and establishing a living connection with God Almighty, we can find God.
- Once we find God through Him having accepted our prayers, we can see the beauties and characteristics that are present in God.

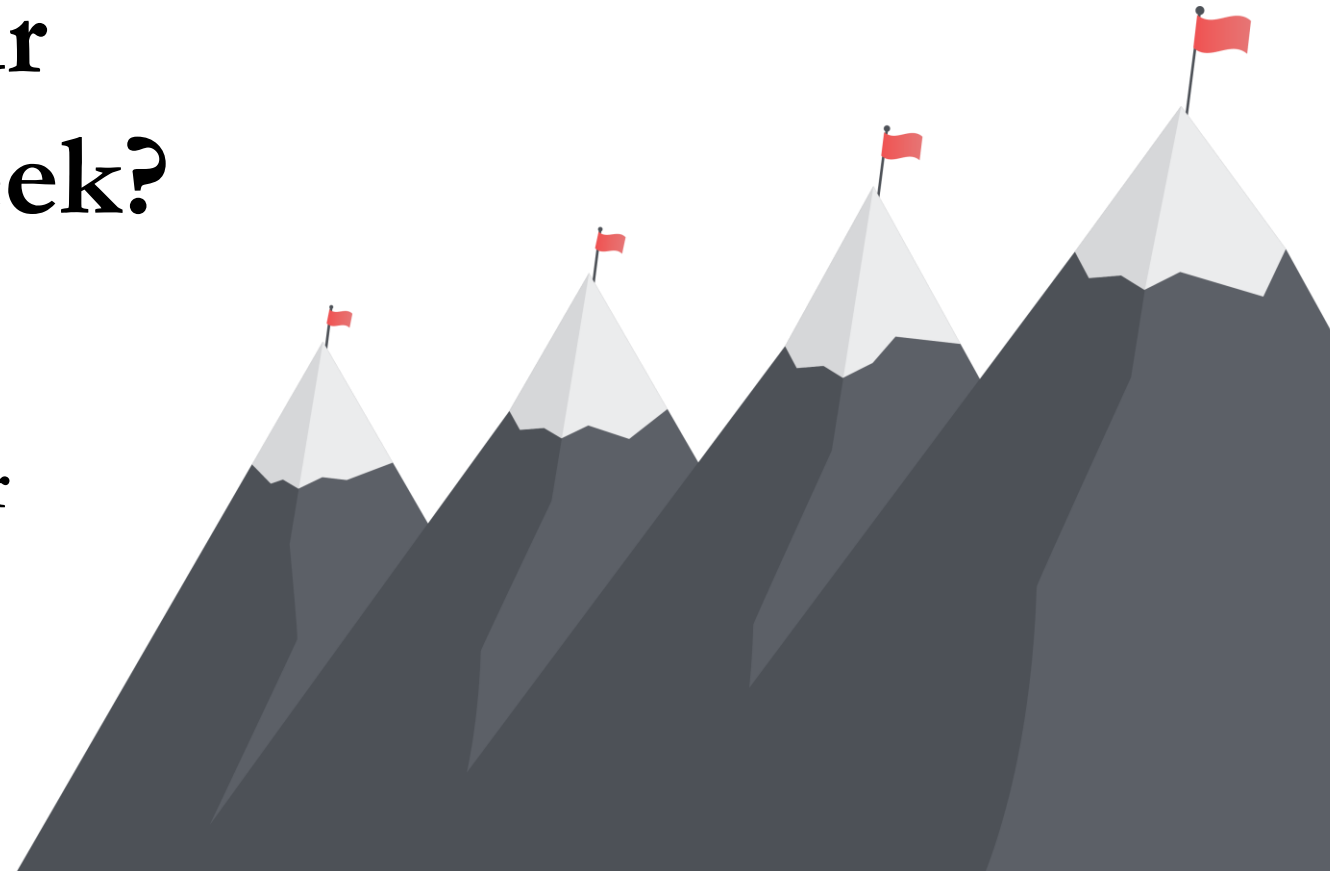

أَشْهَدُ أَنْ لَا إِلَهَ إِلَّا اللَّهُ، وَأَشْهَدُ أَنَّ مُحَمَّدًا  
عَبْدُهُ وَرَسُولُهُ

Ashhadu an lā ilāha illā Allāh, wa ashhadu  
anna Muḥammadan ‘abduhu wa rasūluh

Translation:

I bear witness that there is none worthy of  
worship except Allah and I bear witness that  
Muhammad<sup>sa</sup> is his servant and messenger.

thee alone do we implore for help’

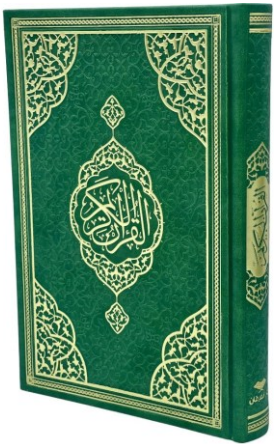


Huzoor<sup>aba</sup> emphasized compassion for others, especially the poor, so that Eid becomes a source of joy for all. He also highlighted the prayer **إِيَّاكَ نَعْبُدُ وَإِيَّاكَ نَسْتَعِينُ** teaching that one must first strive and work hard, then place trust in Allah and seek His help.

Huzoor<sup>aba</sup> explained that Ramadan is for gaining blessings and doing good deeds, and these should continue after Ramadan; otherwise, Eid becomes just a festival without real purpose.

Huzoor<sup>aba</sup> stated that the real Eid is in following the commands of God Almighty found in the Quran.

Huzoor<sup>aba</sup> also drew attention to the pitiable condition of Muslims globally and said that we should remember our fellow Muslims, whose homes are destroyed due to the war caused by corruption.
