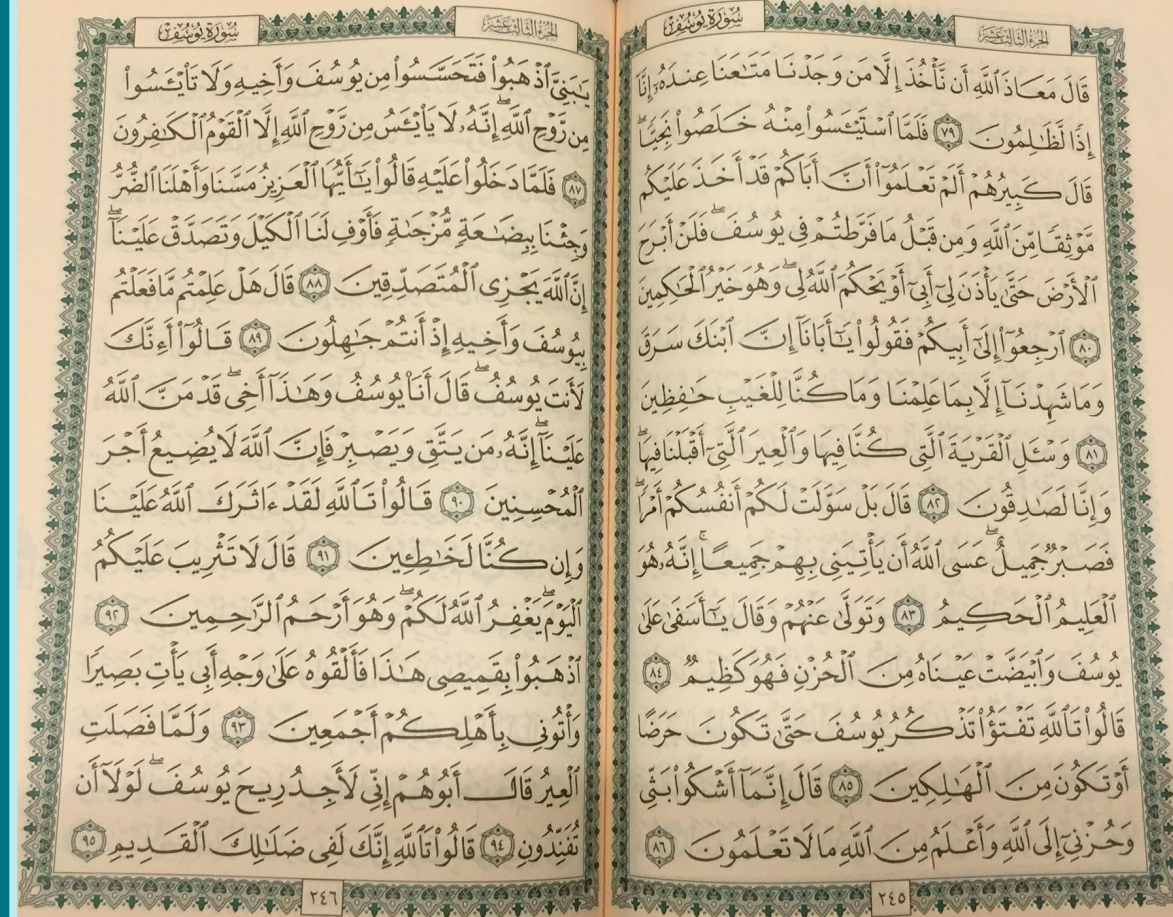
TILAWAT

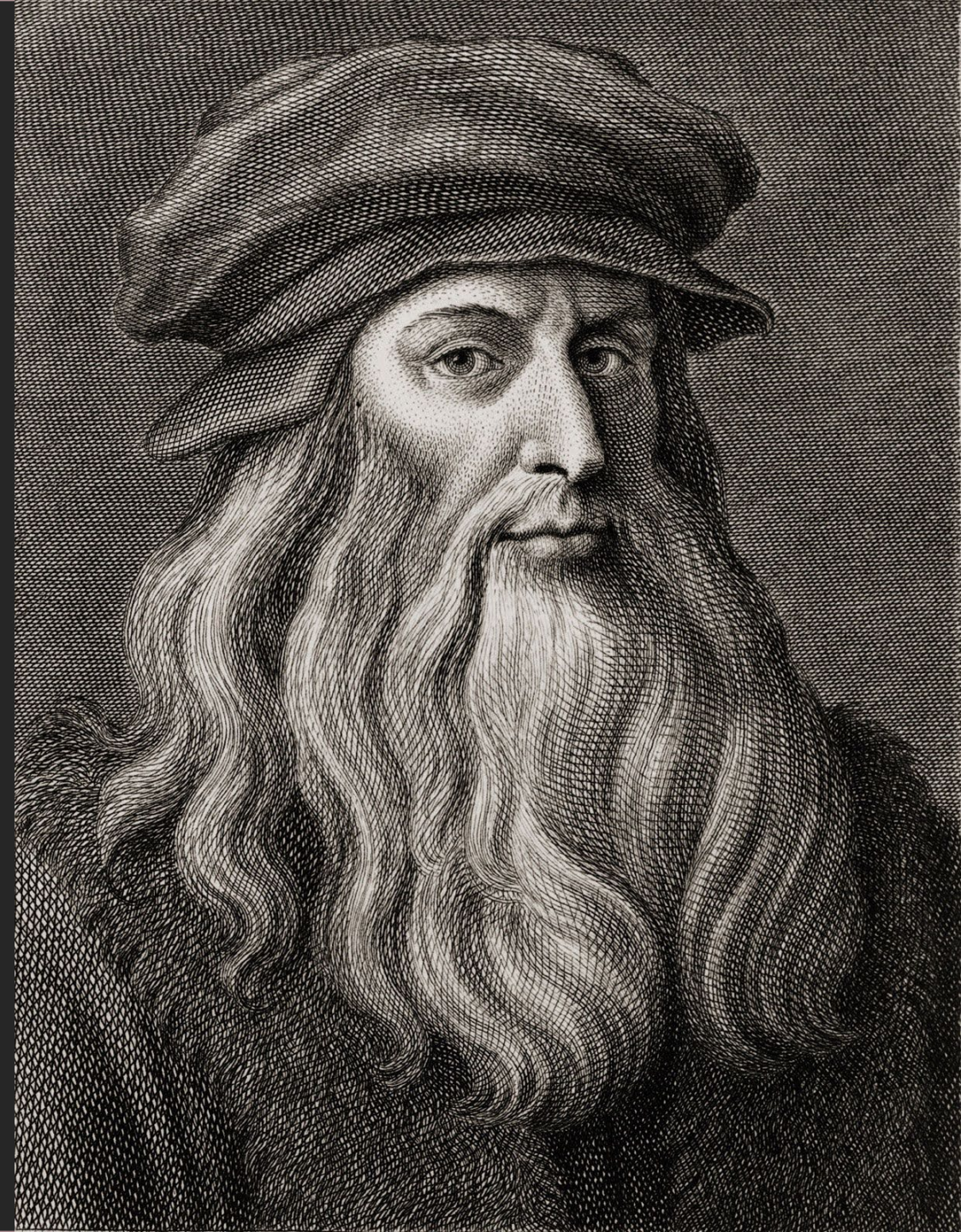

- It is special because it shows beauty and creativity and uses patterns that can go on forever signifying eternity.



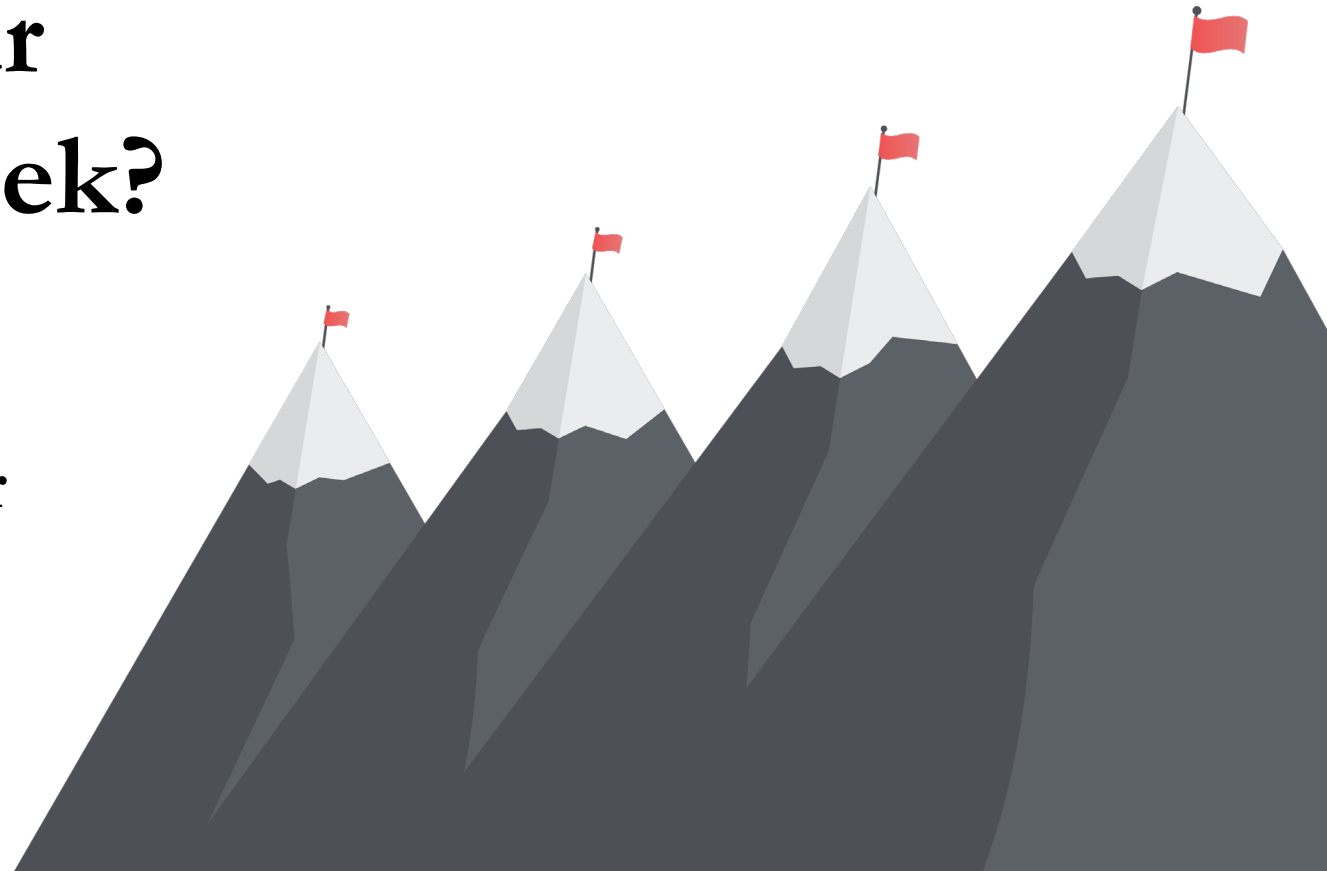
