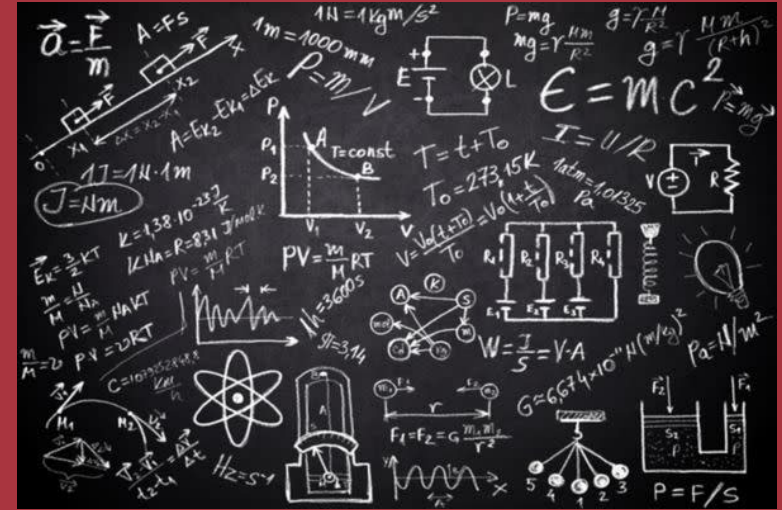

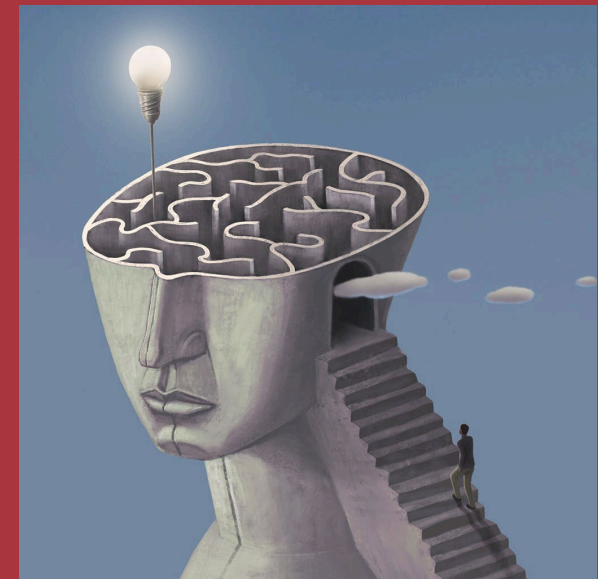
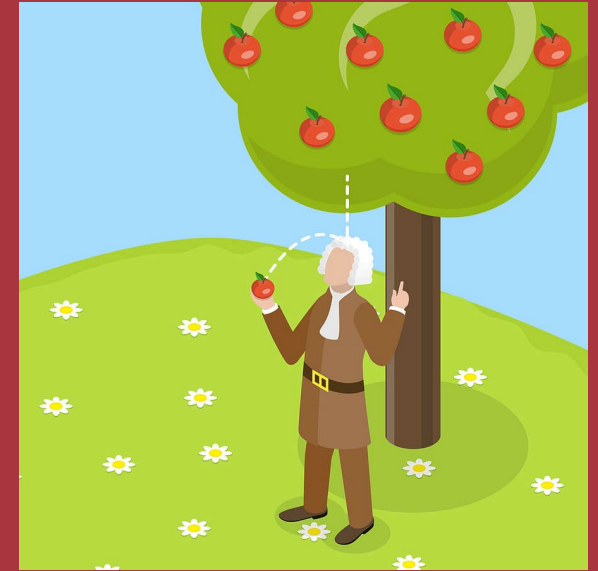
BELIEF OF SCIENCE REGARDING GOD

- Science is a way of learning about the world using experiments, evidence, and observation.
- Science studies things that can be seen, tested, and measured.
- Because of this, science does not prove or disprove God. It stays neutral.
- God is understood as beyond physical testing, so science cannot test Him like it tests nature.



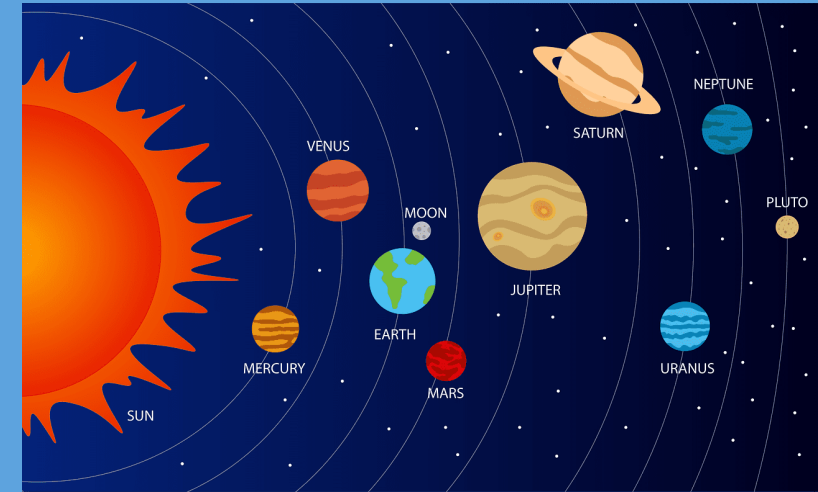
BELIEF OF SCIENCE REGARDING GOD

- Many scientists focus on explaining how the universe works (like gravity & planets).
- Questions like “Why are we here?” or “Who created everything?” are often answered by religion and philosophy, not science alone.
- So science itself stays neutral about God.



BELIEF OF SCIENCE REGARDING GOD

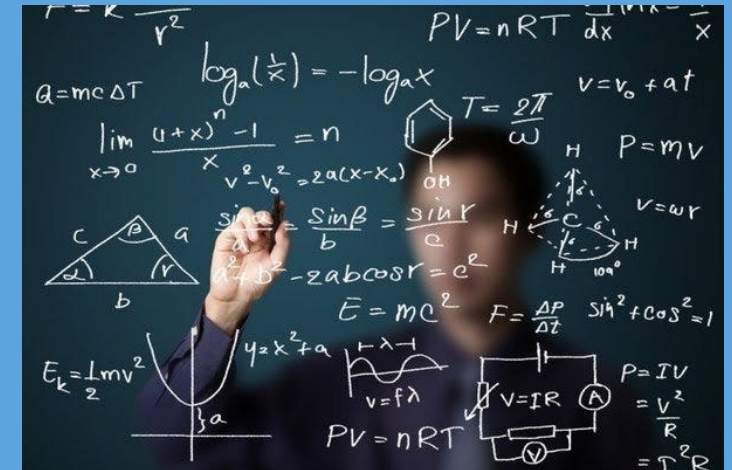
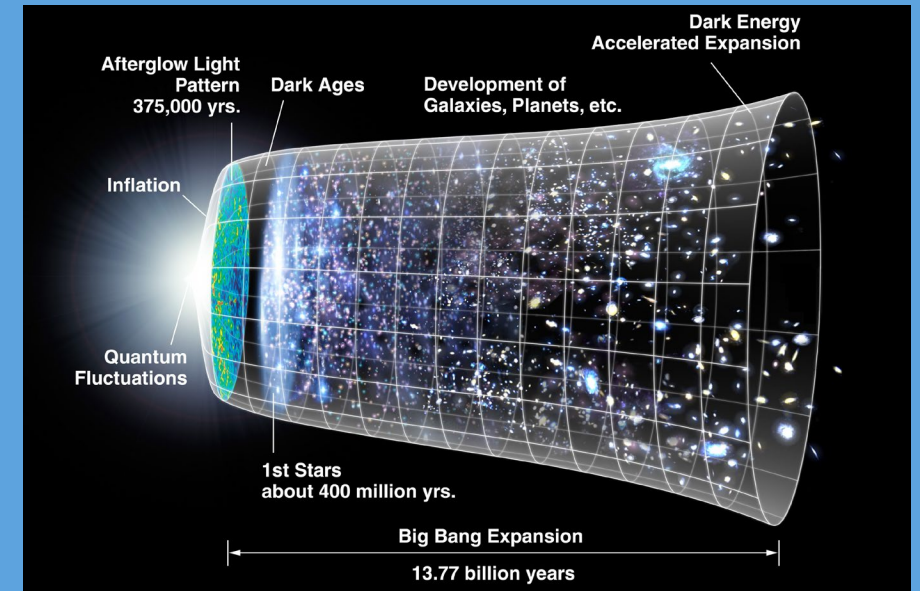
- Some people use science-based ideas to support belief in God:
- The universe is very organized and balanced (like the sun, planets, and laws of nature) which suggests that a Creator exists.
- Life on Earth is very complex, and some believe it did not happen by chance.



BELIEF OF SCIENCE REGARDING GOD

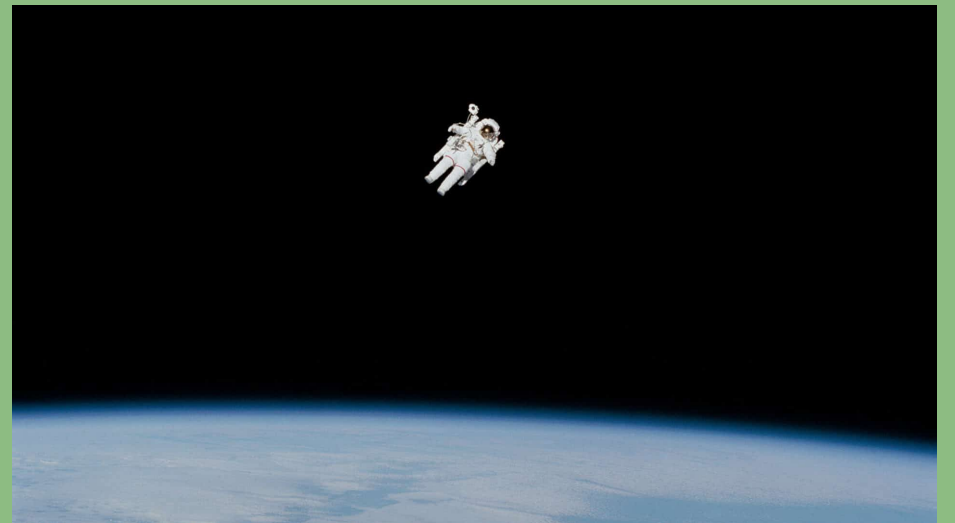
The fact that the universe had a beginning (like the Big Bang) leads some to ask: Who caused it?

Other people (including some scientists) do not agree and believe the universe can be explained without God.



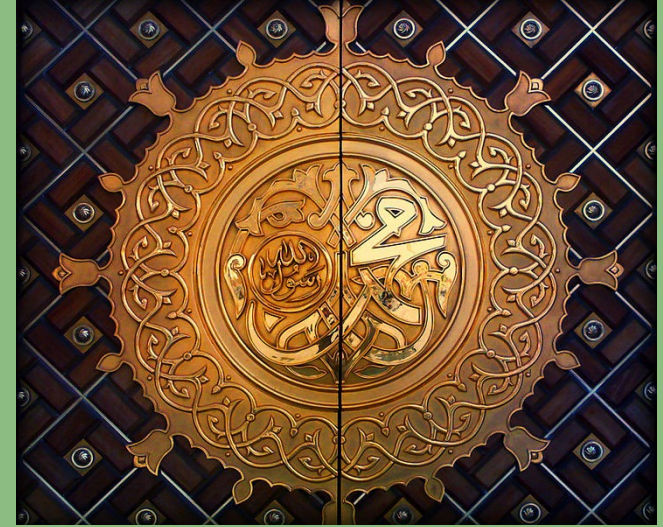
BELIEF OF SCIENCE REGARDING GOD

- It is true that there is no direct, measurable proof of God like in a science experiment.
- But not everything real can be seen or measured.
- For example, we cannot see love, thoughts, or gravity, yet we know they exist by their effects.



BELIEF OF SCIENCE REGARDING GOD

- Many people believe God can be known through His creation, like the universe.
- God has also sent prophets and guidance to help people understand Him.
- Belief in God is also about faith and thinking, not just physical proof.
- If God were fully visible, then belief would not be a choice or test.
