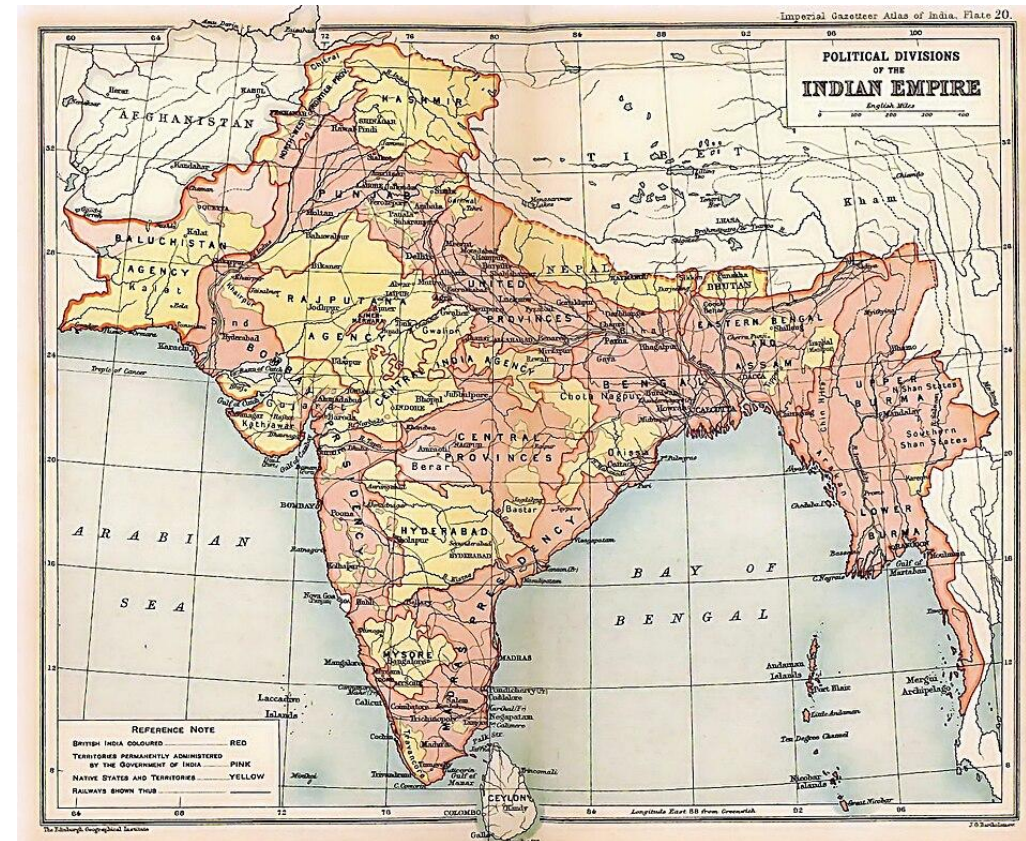
WHAT WAS THE HOLY WAR?

- The Holy War was a debate that took place between the Promised Messiah (as) and one of his opponents, Abdullah Atham.
- Abdullah Atham was a Christian opponent.
- This Debate took place from 22nd May to 5th June 1893 in Amritsar.
- Abdullah Atham was a Muslim by birth but later, on 28th March 1853, he was baptised and converted to Christianity.



EVENTS BEFORE THE DEBATE:

- In 1893, tensions arose in Jandiala, where a local panda (religious teacher) firmly resisted the activities of the Christian medical mission.
- Dr Clark issued a public challenge to a religious debate.
- The Muslims of Jandiala requested the Promised Messiah (as) to represent them.
- Representatives from both parties gathered at Dr Clark's residence to establish the rules for the upcoming debate.

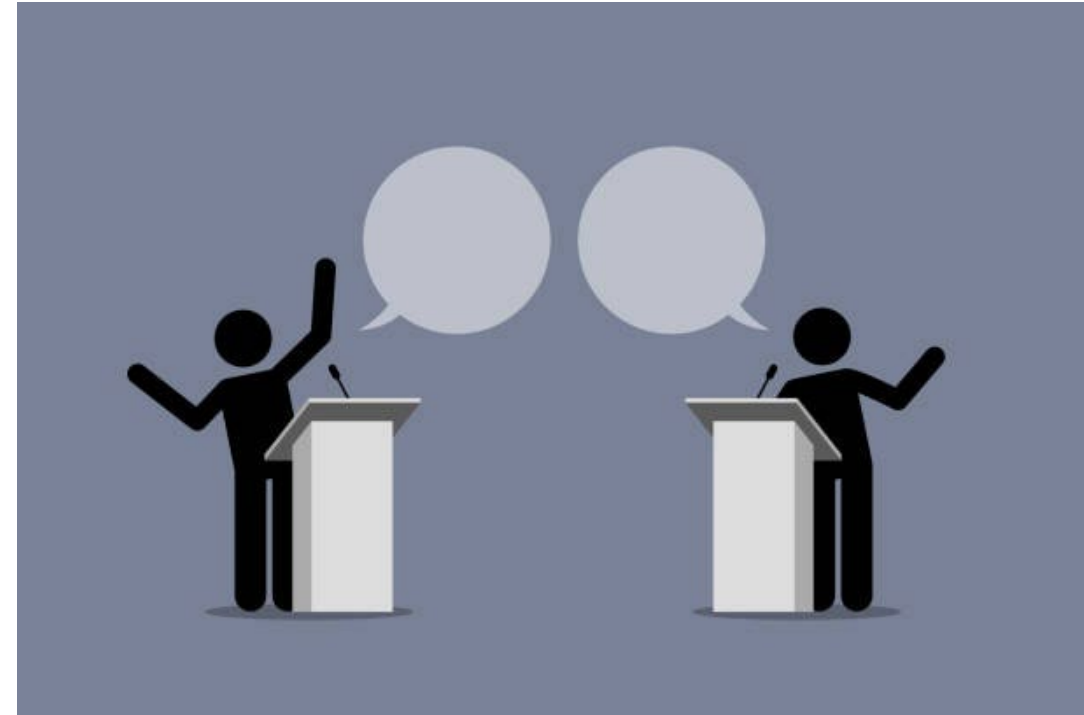


THE DEBATE

- The Debate continued for the next 15 days.
- On the last day of the debate, 5 June 1893, a powerful prophecy was revealed by Allah the Almighty to the Promised Messiah (as).

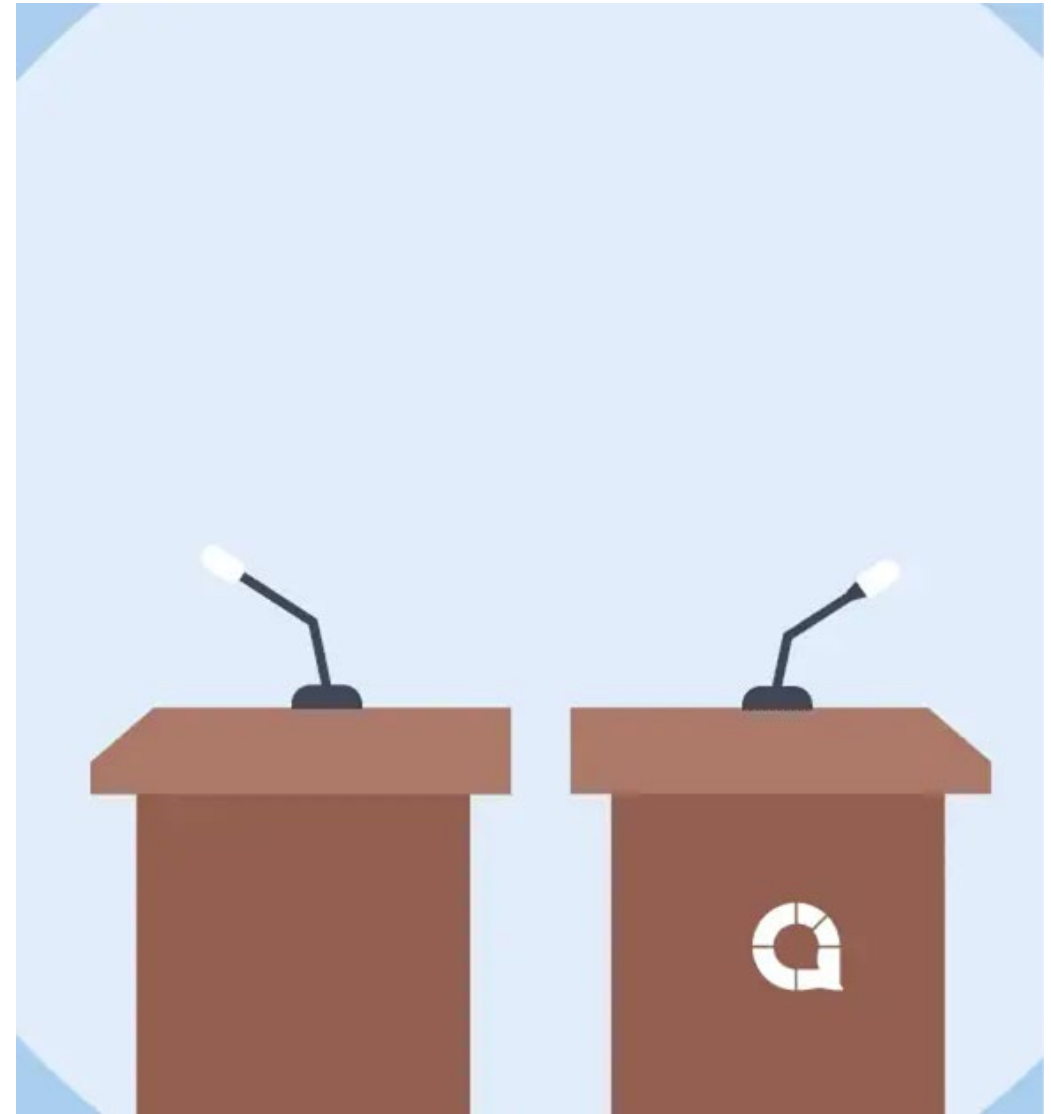
“He gave me this Sign in the form of a glad tidings that in this debate, whichever party from among the two is deliberately adopting falsehood and abandoning the True God and is making a mere mortal into God, will be cast into Hell and utterly disgraced corresponding to the very days of this debate—in other words, taking one month for each day, meaning, within fifteen months.”

(Jang-e-Muqaddas, pp. 287-288)



AFTERMATH OF THE DEBATE

- Dr Martin Clarke was constantly on the run, traveling from Amritsar to his son-in-law.
- He had long since lost the use of his right hand and had recently told his wife that he felt death was near.
- He lost his voice as well.
- On 27th July 1896, Dr Martin Clarke passed away.

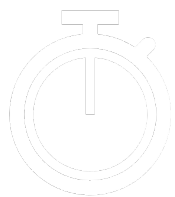

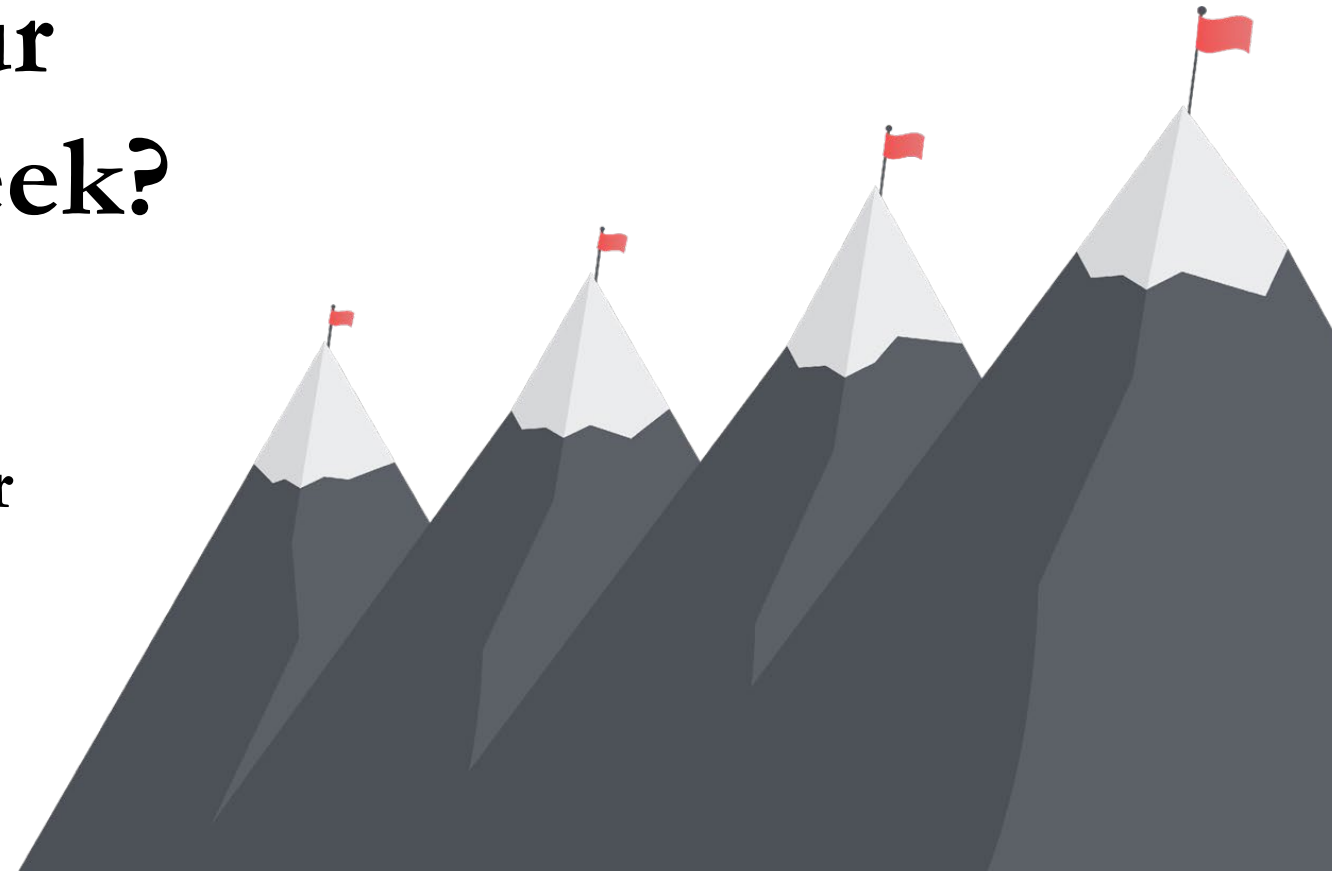

The Pinnacle of Humanity Humility in the Life of the Prophet (sa)

Ahmadis believe that if ever there was a perfect person in the world, it was the Holy Prophet Muhammad (sa).

The Holy Prophet (sa) once said that a person who adopts humility ascended to the seventh heaven.

Once, the Holy Prophet (sa) was heard praying, 'O Allah, let me live in meekness, let me die in meekness, and raise me up among the meek.'



It is recorded that whenever the Holy Prophet (sa) met the Ansar, he would greet their children, place his hand on their heads and pray for them.

Once, a man went to the Holy Prophet (sa) to speak with him, but due to the awe of being in the presence of the Holy Prophet (sa), the man began shaking. The Holy Prophet (sa) told him to remain calm, for he was the son of a woman who would eat dried meat.



On the way to the Battle of Badr, there were three people assigned to one camel. When it was the Holy Prophet (sa)'s turn to walk, his two companions requested that he continue sitting on the camel while they walked. The Holy Prophet (sa) replied by saying that they did not have more endurance to walk than he did, nor was he any different from them, and insisted that they rode on the camel while he walked.
