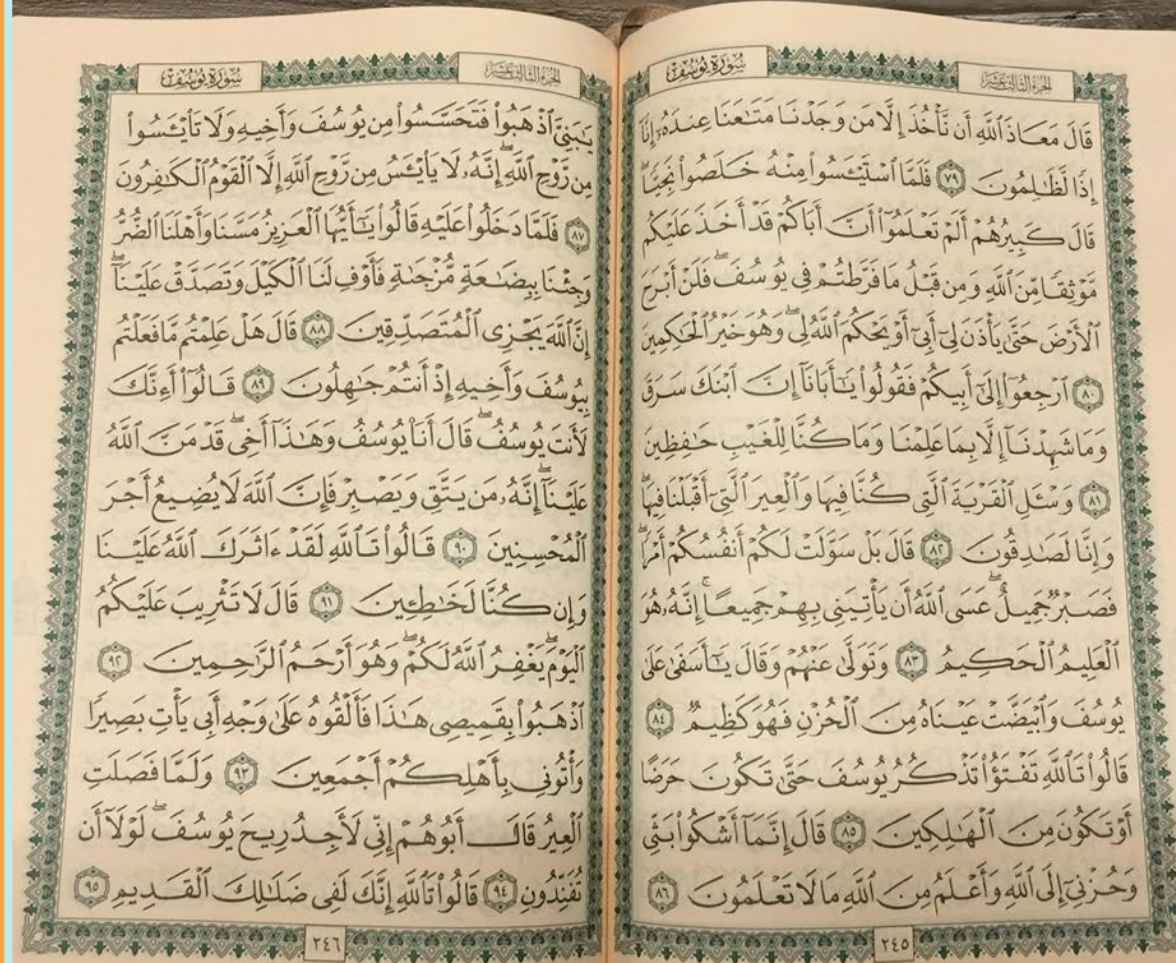

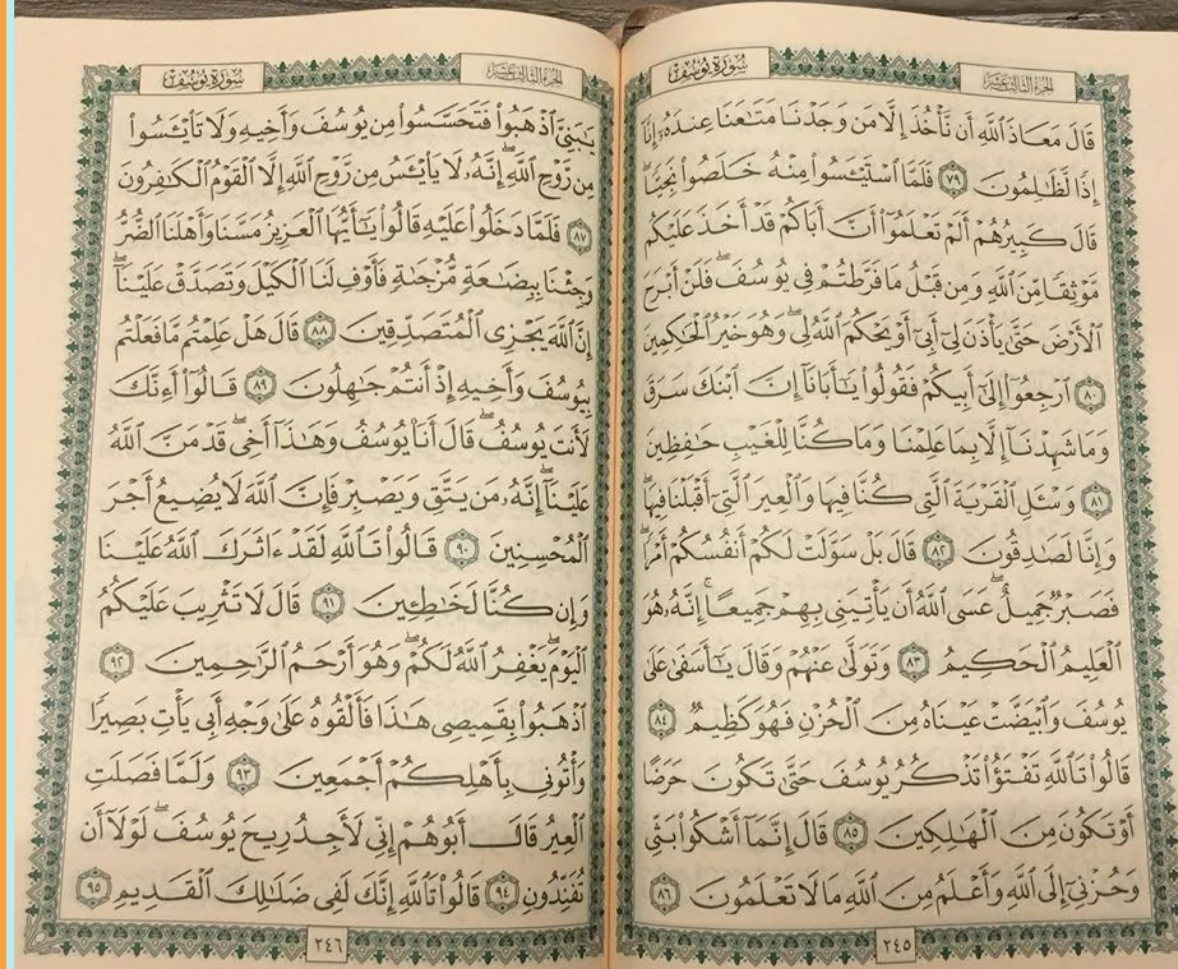

HADITH

The Holy Prophet (saw) said: “Prophethood shall remain among you as long as Allah shall will. He will bring about its end and follow it with Khilafat on the precepts of prophethood for as long as He shall will and then bring about its end. A tyrannical monarchy will then follow and will remain as long as Allah shall and then come to an end. There will thereafter monarchial despotism to last as long as Allah shall and come to an end upon His decree. There will then emerge Khilafat on the precept of Prophethood.” The Holy Prophet said no more.”

WHAT IS KHILAFAT?

- The word “Khilafat” means successorship.
- The Ahmadi sect is the only sect that is led by a Khalifa.
- 27th May 2026 will be the start of the 118th year of Khilafat.
- The Promised Messiah (as) mentioned the system of Khilafat in his book “The Will.”



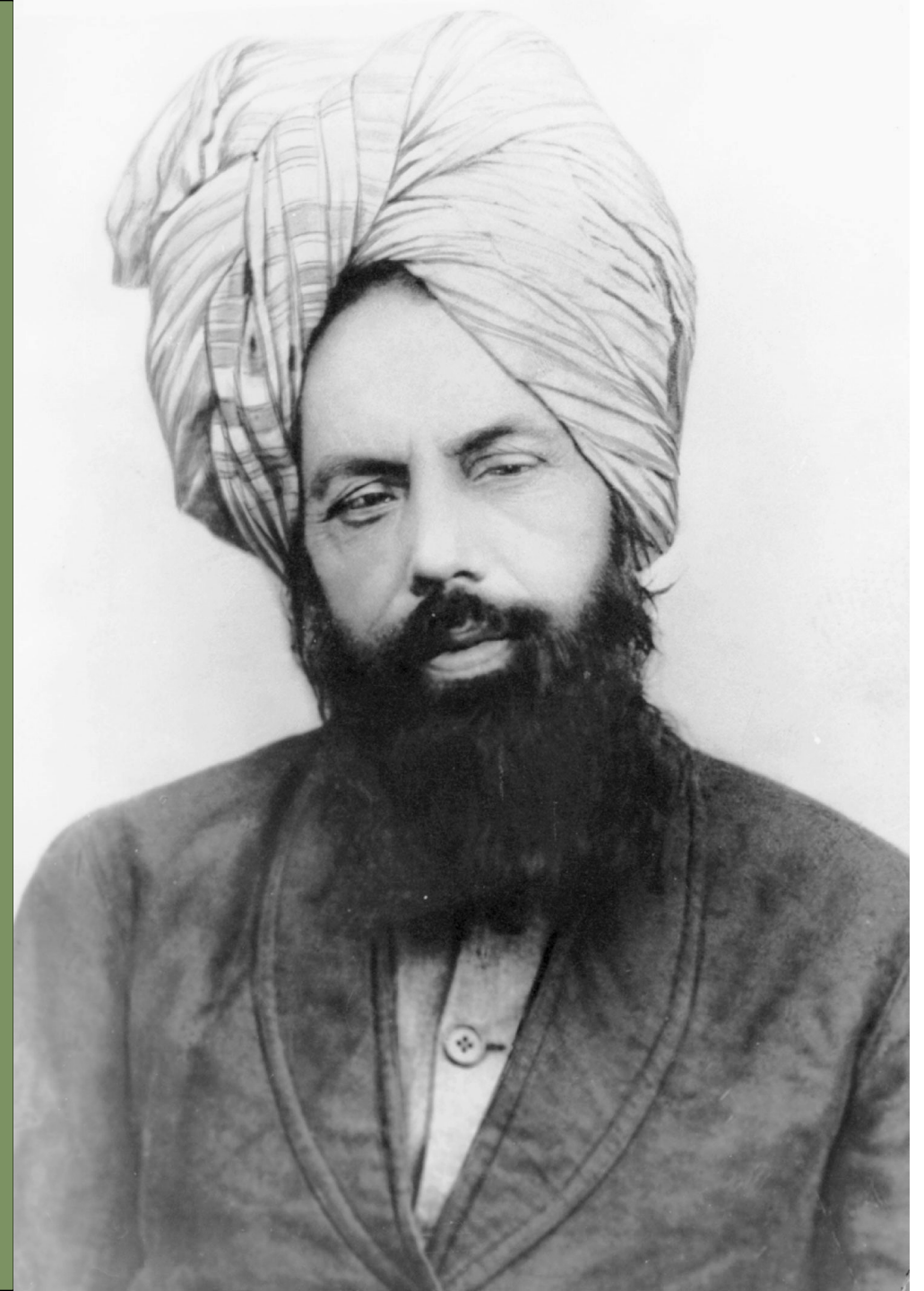
WHY DO WE NEED KHILAFAT?

- A Khalifa is chosen to lead his followers.
- We see that the other 72 sects that are present are not led by a Khalifa.
- This is why there are a lot of misconceptions and misunderstandings that have occurred in their beliefs.
- However, because the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community has followed under one leadership for the past 118 years, they have maintained their beliefs throughout.



WHEN DOES THE SYSTEM OF KHILAFAT COMMENCE?

- The system of Khilafat commences after the coming of a Prophet.
- That Prophet can be a law bearing or a non law bearing Prophet.
- For example, the system of Khilafat commenced after the coming of both the Holy Prophet Muhammad (saw) and the Promised Messiah (as).



HOW ARE THE KHULAFAT CHOSEN?

- For a Khalifa to be elected, there is an electoral college set up which includes members of the Jama'at that are high in authority or have a good understanding of the system of the Jama'at.
- The members of the Electoral College sit and nominate candidates.



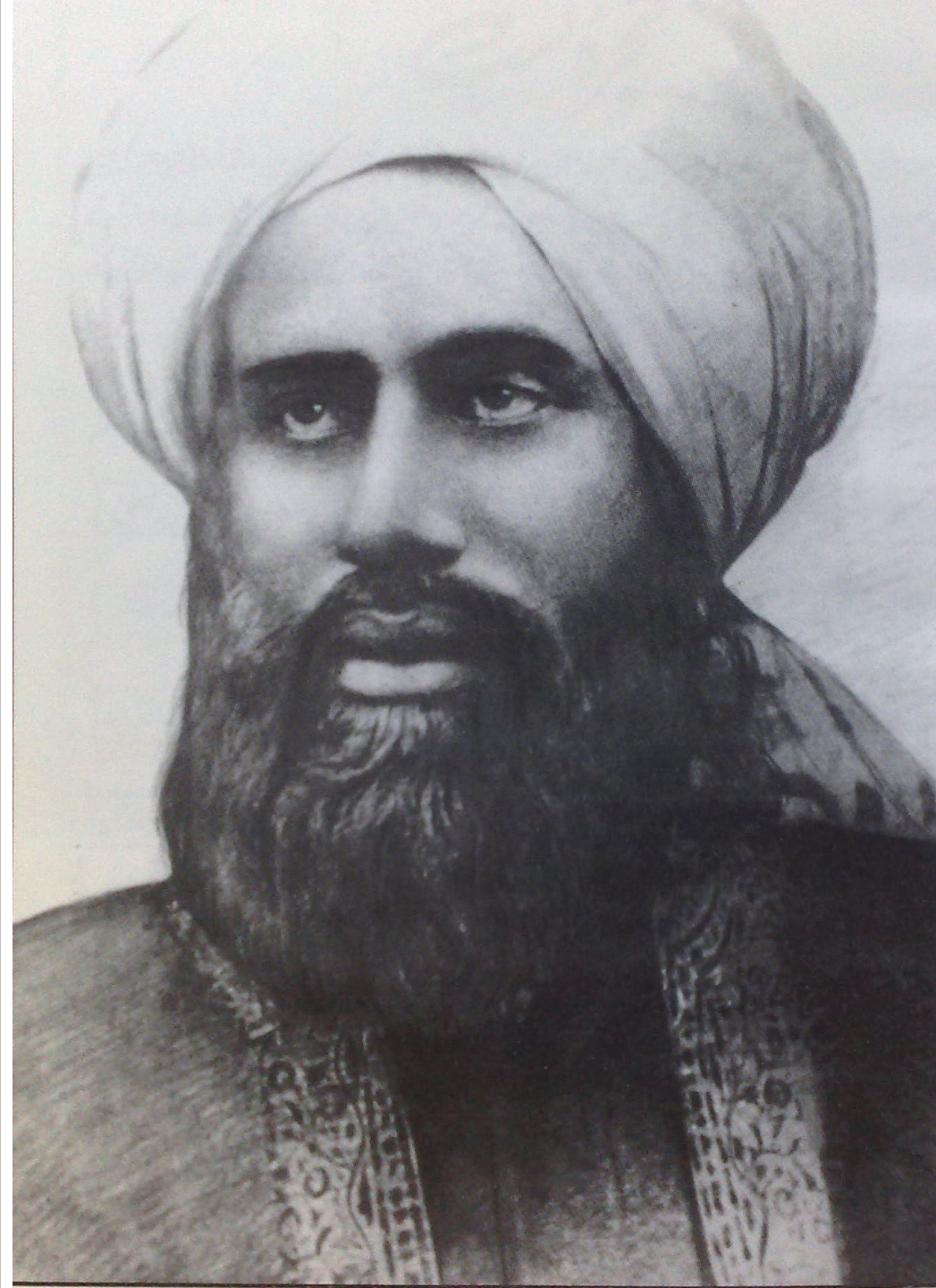
HOW ARE THE KHULAFAs CHOSEN?

- After the names of candidates have been presented, the system of voting takes place and a Khalifa is elected.
- However, from the incidents of members that have been present in this committee, they believe that it is Allah who had put in their hearts the candidate that they voted for and believe that a Khalifa is divinely elected.



WHY DO WE CELEBRATE JALSA KHILAFAT?

- It is important to understand that the Promised Messiah (as) passed away on 26th May 1908.
- The very next day, Hazrat Hakeem Maulvi Noor-ud-Din Sahib (ra) was elected as the first Khalifa of the Ahmadiyya Muslim Community.
- Therefore, Jalsa Khilafat is celebrated as a joyous occasion—Allah the Almighty continued to support the Jama'at and established the system of Khilafat so that the Jama'at would continue to progress.

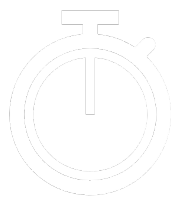

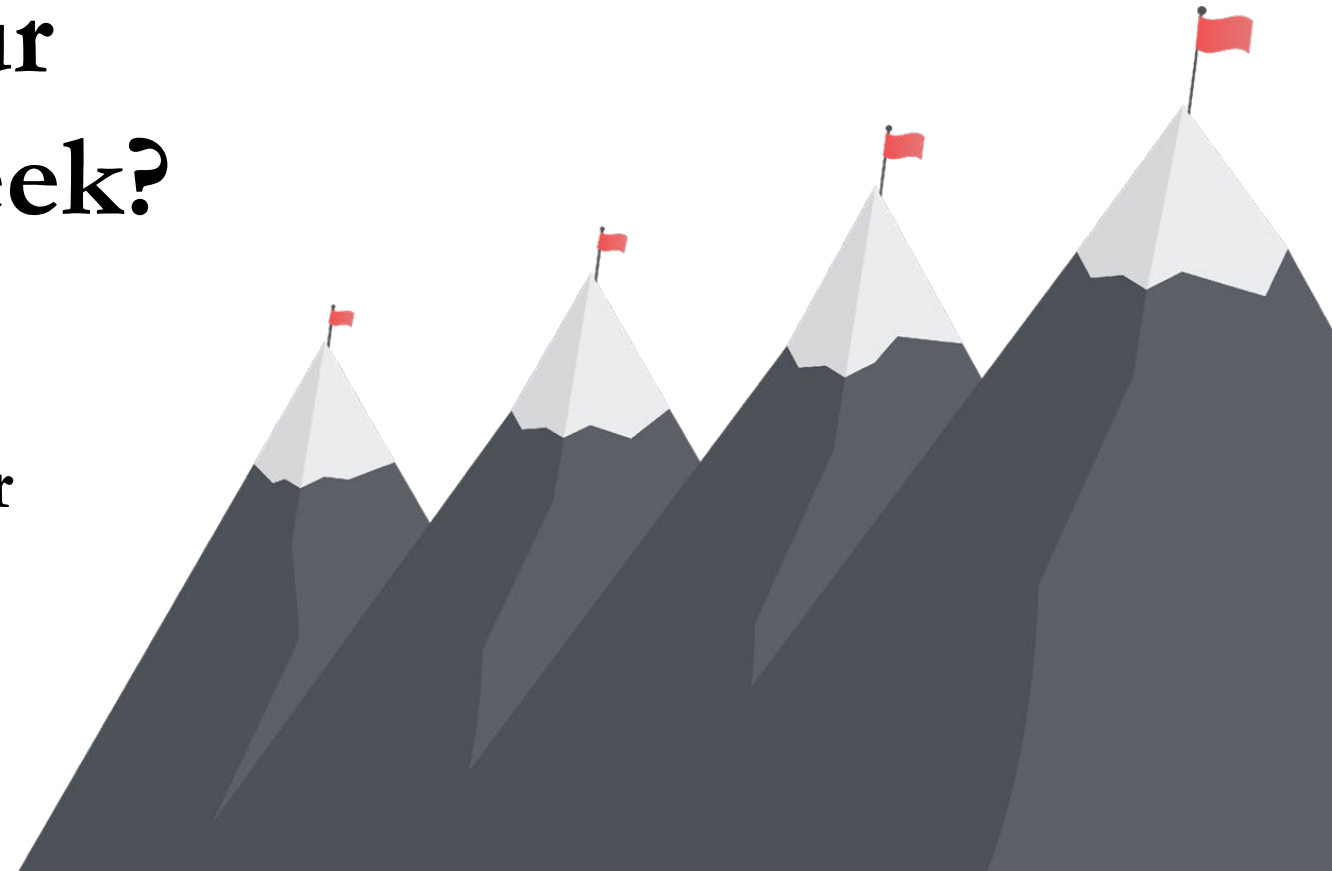
