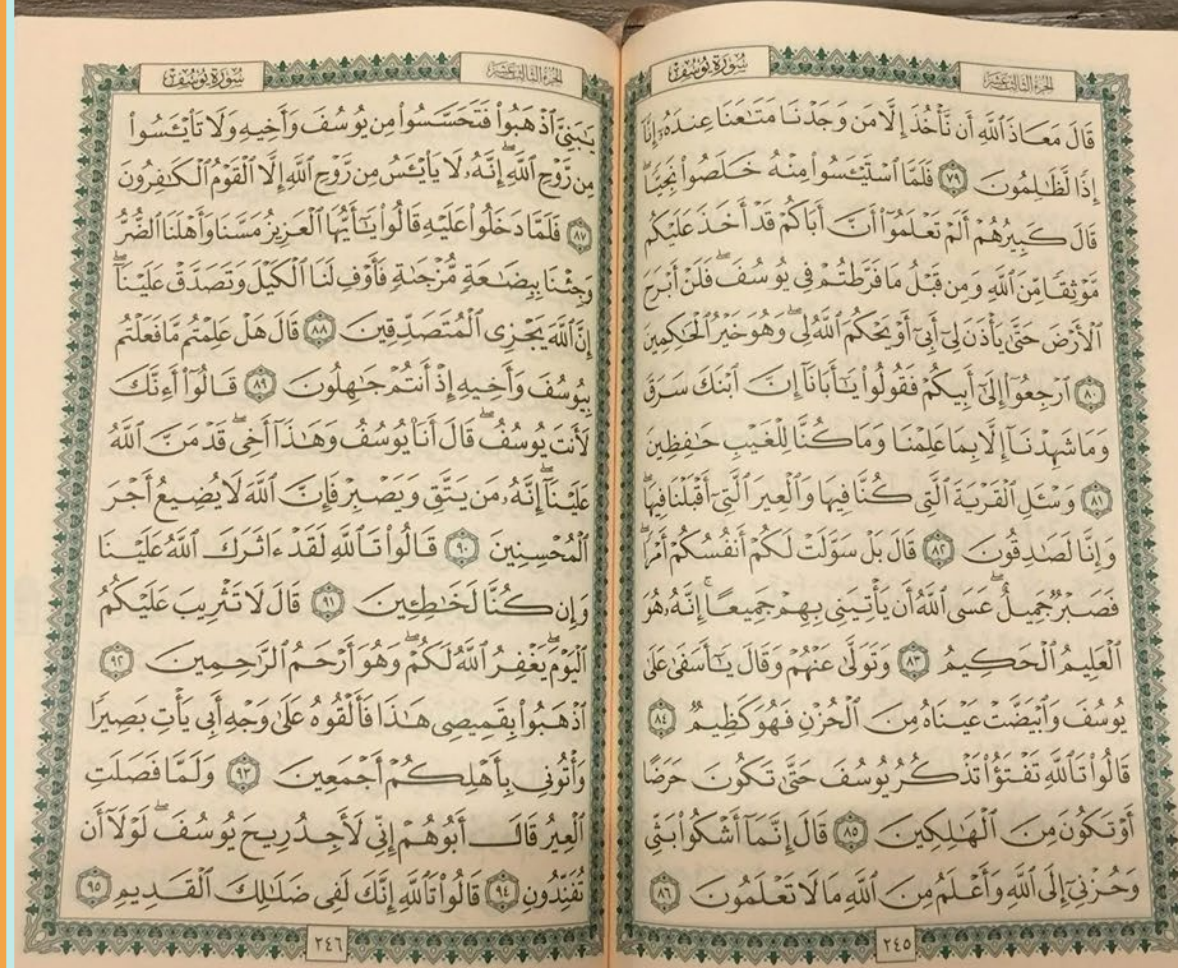

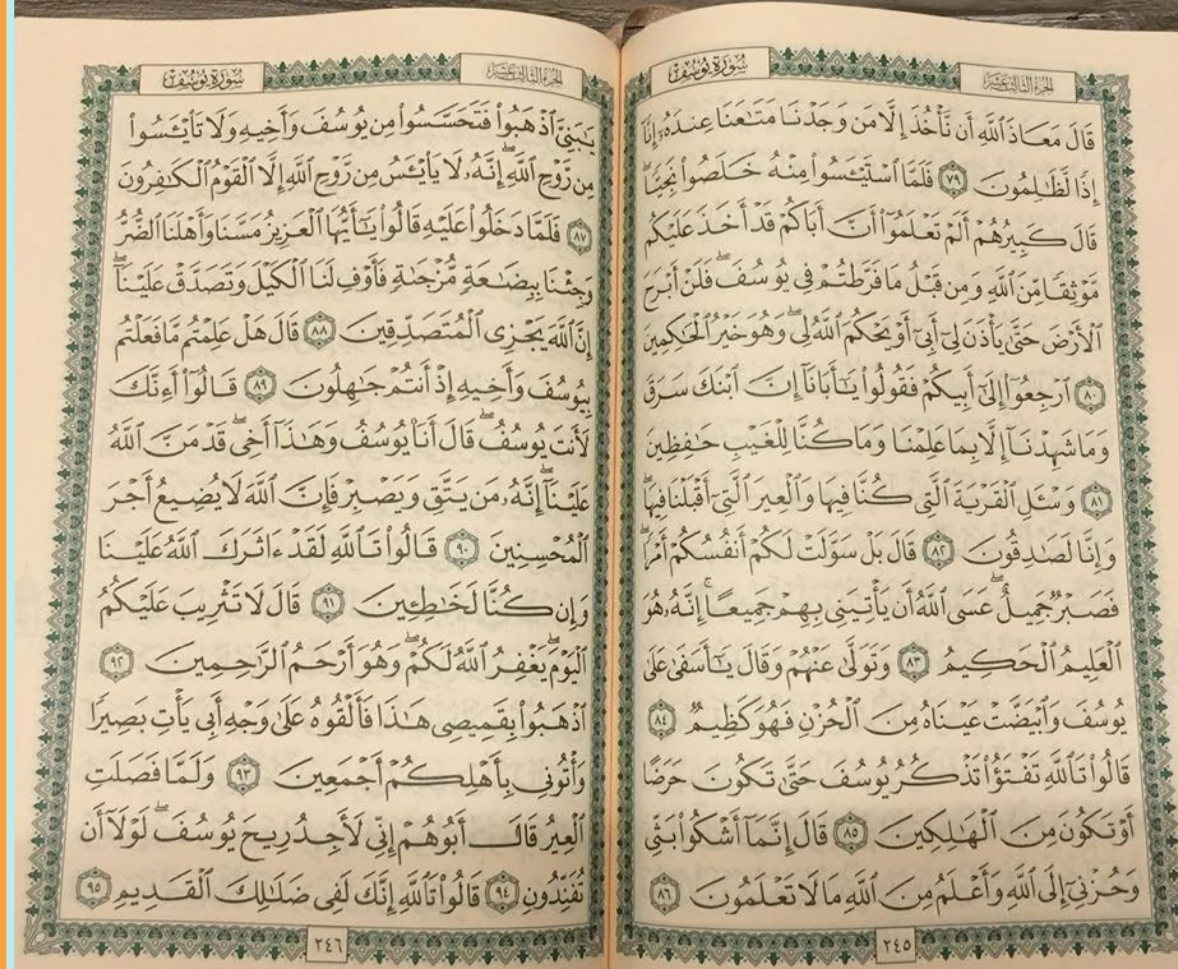

HADITH

(sayings of the Holy Prophet Muhammad^{sas})

عَنِ الْبَرَاءِ قَالَ سَمِعْتُ النَّبِيَّ صَلَّى اللَّهُ عَلَيْهِ وَسَلَّمَ يَخْطُبُ
فَقَالَ إِنَّ أَوَّلَ مَا نَبْدَأُ مِنْ يَوْمِنَا هَذَا أَنْ نُصَلِّيَ ثُمَّ نَرْجِعَ
فَنَنْحَرَ فَمَنْ فَعَلَ فَقَدْ أَصَابَ سُنَّتَنَا

Narrated by Hazrat Al-Bara' (RA): He said, "I heard the Prophet ﷺ say:

'The first thing we do on this day of our festival is perform the prayer. Then we return and offer the sacrifice. Whoever does that has acted in accordance with our Sunnah (way and practice)."

WHAT IS EID UL ADHA?

- Eid ul Adha is a joyous festival that is celebrated once a year.
- It is celebrated approximately 2 months and 10 days after Eid ul Fitr.
- Eid ul Adha is an Eid known for sacrificing.
- It is celebrated on 10th of Dhul Hijjah (the 12th month of the Islamic Calendar)



SIGNIFICANCE OF EID UL ADHA?

- This Eid is celebrated remembering the sacrifice Hazrat Ibrahim (as) performed.
- In a dream Hazrat Ibrahim (as) saw himself sacrifice his son, Hazrat Ismael (as) in the way of Allah the Almighty.
- Without hesitation, Hazrat Ibrahim (as) obeyed the instructions and as he was about to physically sacrifice his son, Allah the Almighty stopped him.
- Because Hazrat Ibrahim (as) had shown complete obedience to Allah, Allah instead instructed him to sacrifice an animal.
- Because of this sacrifice, Muslims celebrate Eid ul Adha and sacrifice animals.



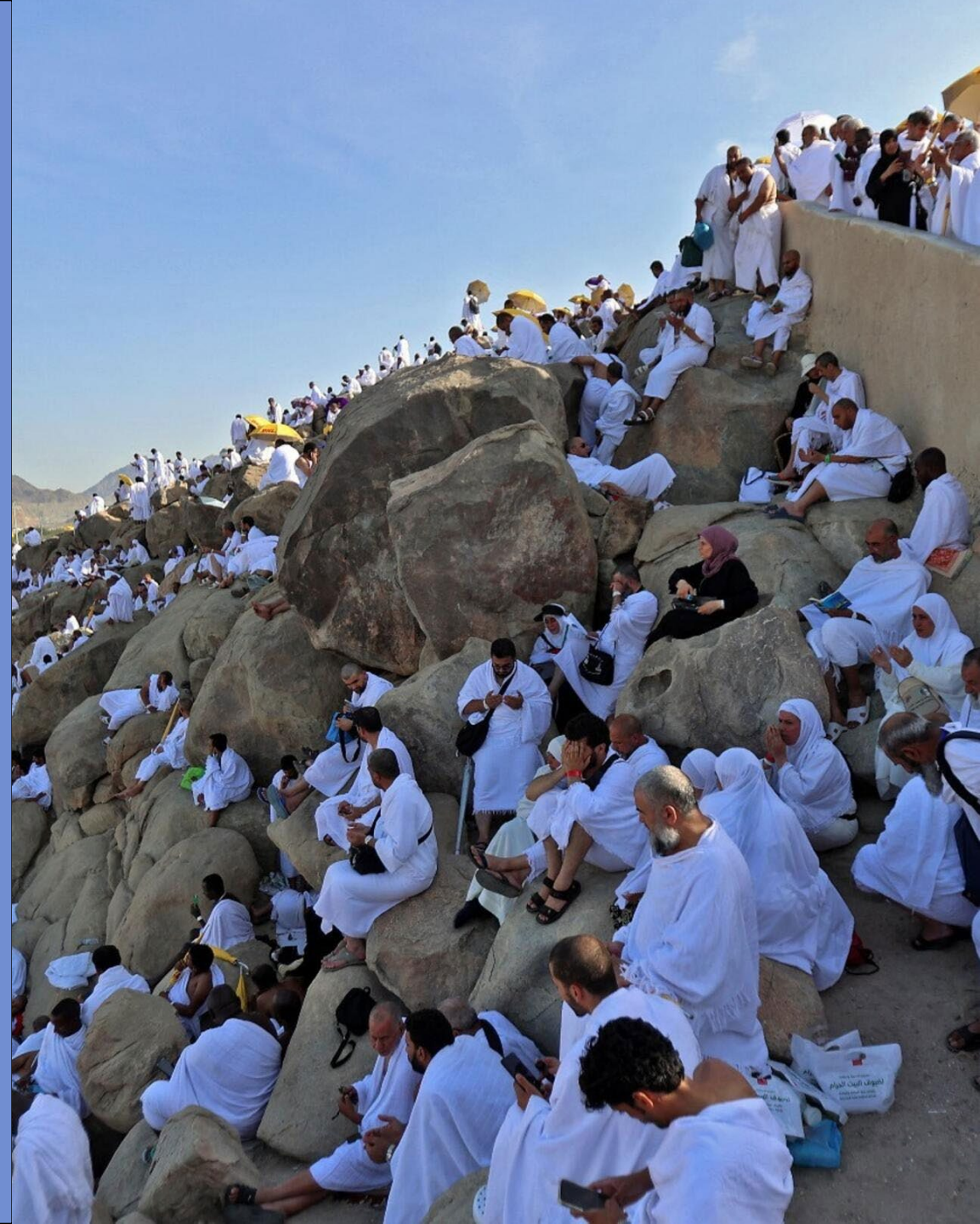
SIGNIFICANCE OF HAJJ IN EID UL ADHA

- Hajj is linked very closely to Eid ul Adha.
- Many Muslims across the world perform Hajj starting from 8th Dhul Hijjah which concludes on 13th Dhul Hijjah.
- A brief breakdown of how Hajj is performed is as follows:
 - A person wears the Ihram and then starts by saying the Talbiyya.
 - Then, he performs 7 circuits of the Ka'aba anti clockwise.
 - Then, he runs between Safa and Marwa 7 times as well.



SIGNIFICANCE OF HAJJ IN EID UL ADHA

- A brief breakdown of how Hajj is performed is as follows:
 - Then, a pilgrim travels to Mina where he spends the time.
 - Then, a pilgrim travels to Arafat where he offers prayers and listens to a Sermon.
 - The pilgrim comes to Muzdalifa where the person spends the night.
 - The next morning, he returns to Mina on 10th Dhul Hijjah.
 - On this day, he throws pebbles on the pillars as well as sacrificing an animal and cutting off the hair.



SIGNIFICANCE OF HAJJ IN EID UL ADHA

- A brief breakdown of how Hajj is performed is as follows:
 - The pilgrim then performs another Tawaaf of the Ka'aba as well as running between Safa and Marwa.
 - The Pilgrim then goes back to Mina where for the next 2 days they continue their worship and strike pebbles on the pillar.
 - Then on 12/13th Dhul Hijjah, a pilgrimage returns back to Makkah where he performs one final Tawwaf of the Ka'aba and the Hajj is complete.

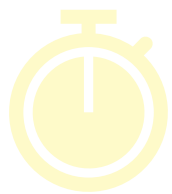

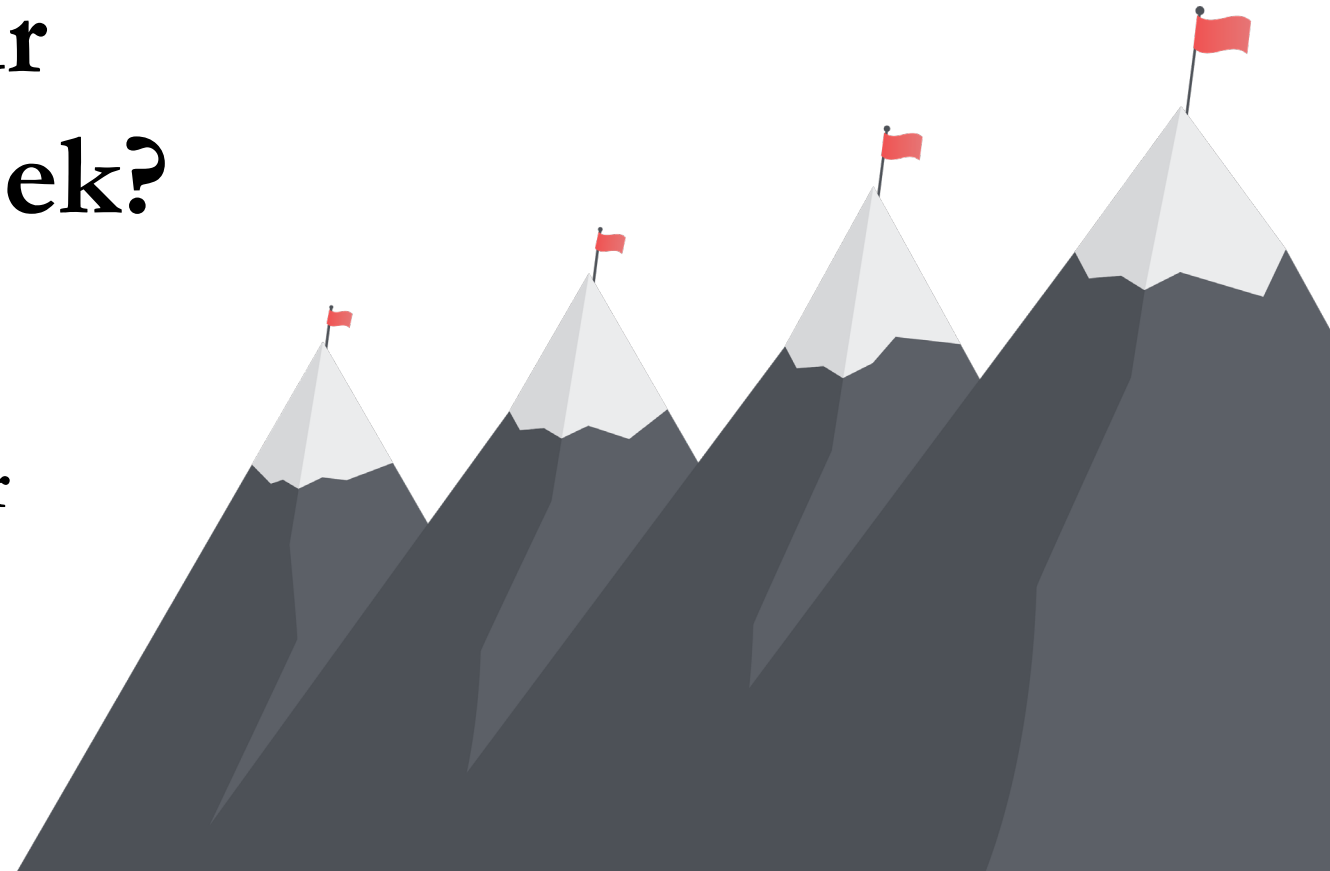

Every Step in Humility: The Prophet (sa)

Once, it was said that the Holy Prophet (sa) eats like a slave and sits as a slave does, for after all, he was a human too. In other words, the Holy Prophet (sa) did not have the qualities of self-pride and ostentation as did other worldly rulers.



Whenever a person came before the Holy Prophet^(sa) to meet him and shook his hand, the Holy Prophet^(sa) would not let go of that person's hand until they let go. Similarly, he would not turn away from the person until they turned away first.

Once the Holy Prophet^(sa) slept on a cot that left marks on his back. Some companions requested that they be allowed to make a softer bed for him. The Holy Prophet^(sa) said that he was not concerned with the comforts of this world. He said he was like a traveller who stops in the shade of a tree for a while, then leaves and moves on.



The Holy Prophet^(sa) himself would sweep the mosque to clean it and never considered such work to be beneath him.

Once, an angel descended upon the Holy Prophet^(sa) who had never descended upon anyone else before. This angel asked the Holy Prophet^(sa) if he would be considered a King and Prophet or a servant and Messenger. Such was the humble nature of the Holy Prophet^(sa) that he chose the option of being regarded as a servant and Messenger.
