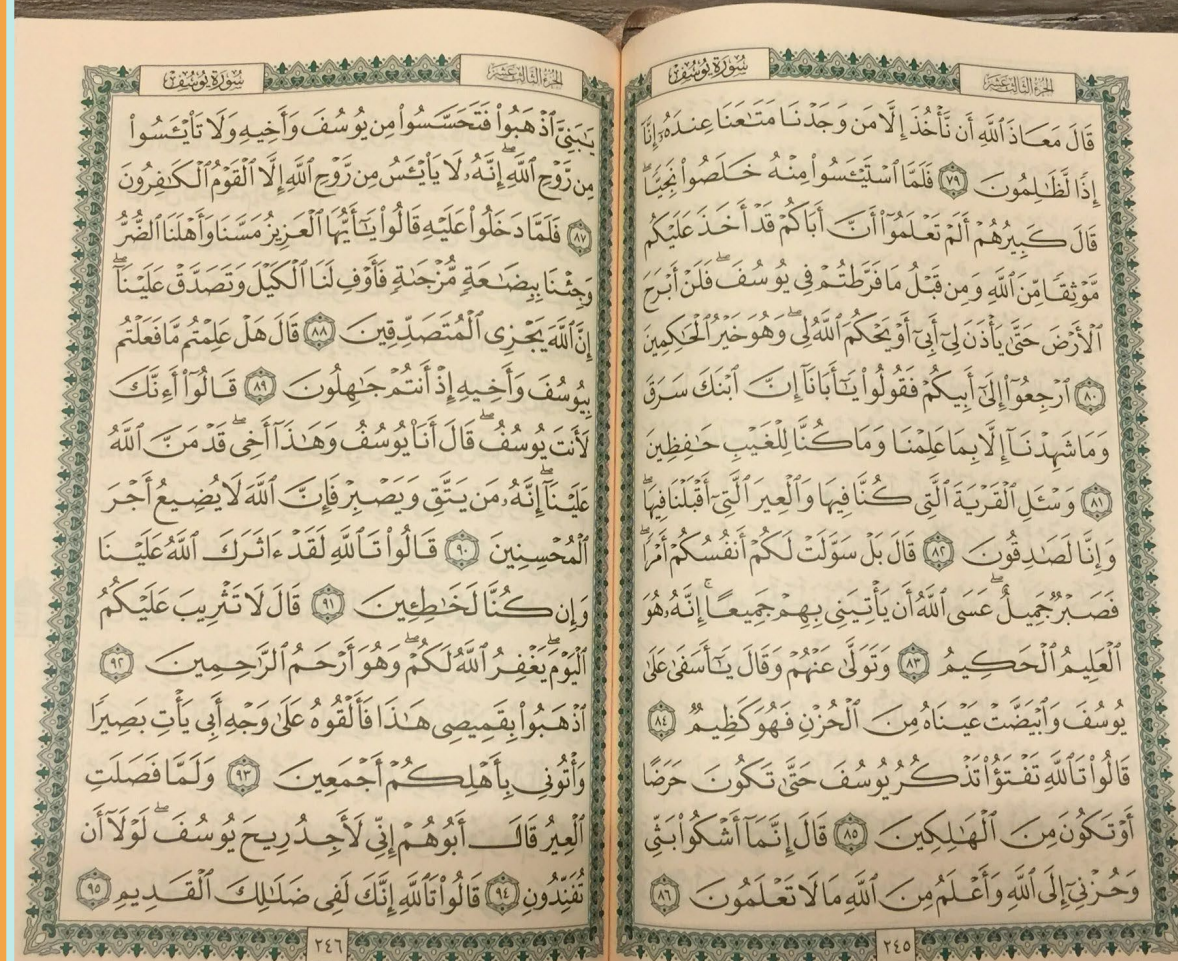
TILAWAT

TRANSLATION

WHO WAS NELSON MANDELA?

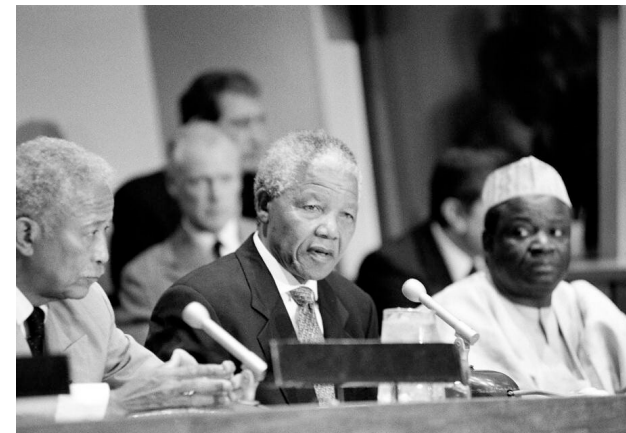
- Nelson Mandela was a leader from South Africa.
- He was born on July 18, 1918.
- He fought against a system called apartheid, which treated people differently based on the colour of their skin.
- Mandela believed that all people should have equal rights and opportunities.
- Because of his activism he was arrested and spent 27 years in prison.



WHO WAS NELSON MANDELA?

(CONTINUED)

- After Mandela was released from prison in 1990, he worked to bring people together peacefully.
- In 1993, he received the Nobel Peace Prize for helping promote peace and reconciliation.
- In 1994, he became the first Black President of South Africa.
- He passed away on December 5, 2013.



FUN FACTS ABOUT NELSON MANDELA

- He loved learning and studied law.
- Mandela enrolled in the University of London's correspondence program and received a Bachelor of Law degree, all while he was still in prison.
- He received more than 695 awards.
- More than 25 schools, universities, and education institutions have been named after Nelson Mandela. At least 19 scholarships and foundations bear his name.



SIGNIFICANCE OF NELSON MANDELA INTERNATIONAL DAY

- In 2009, the United Nations proclaimed Mandela's birthday (July 18th) to be Nelson Mandela International Day.
- The holiday asks people to spend 67 minutes doing something good for others, which represents the 67 years he spent working towards change.



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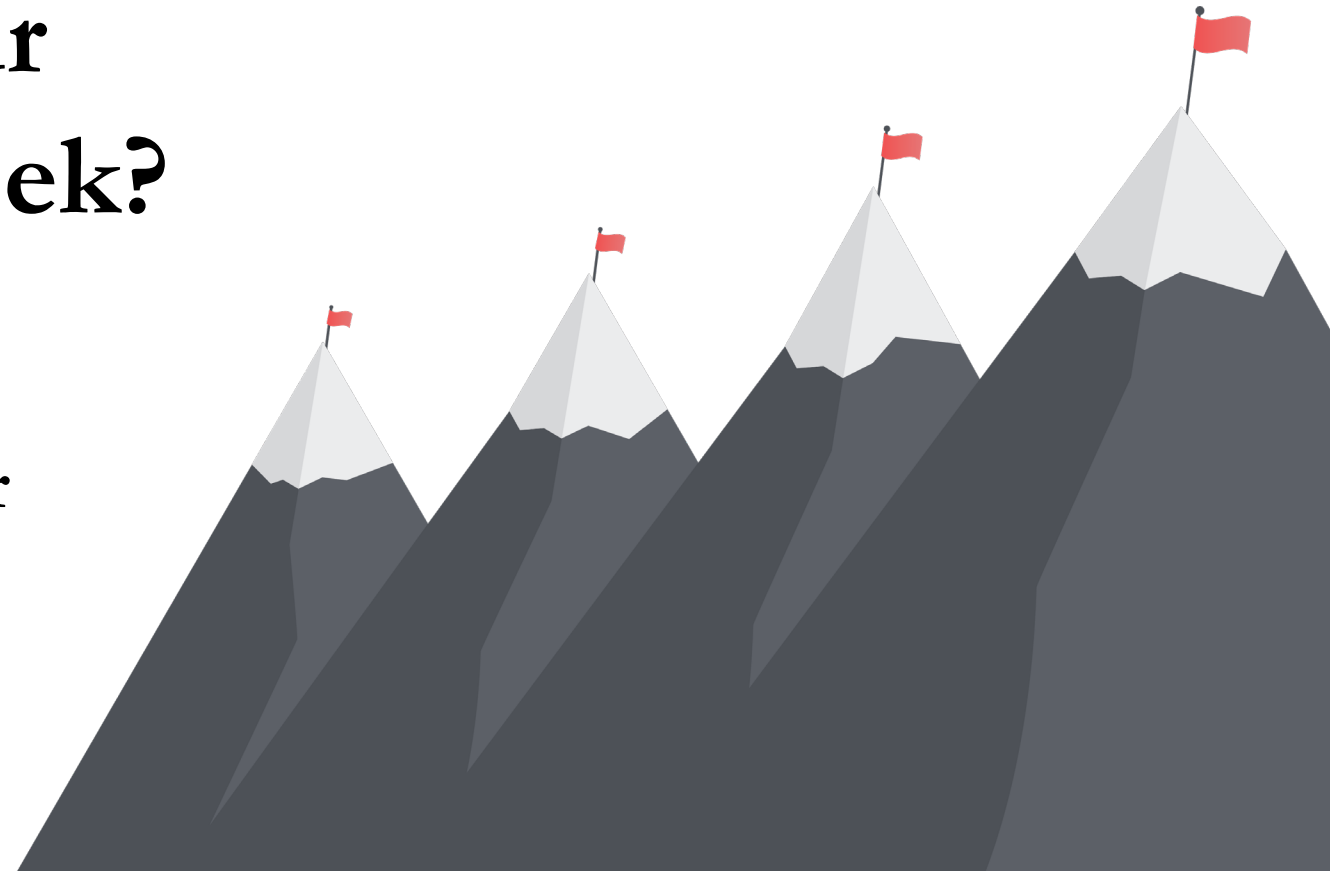

“Generosity and Ihsan in the life of the Promised Messiah^(as)”

The Promised Messiah (as) would show kindness even to those who opposed him.

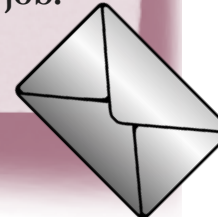
At various times, Mirza Imamuddin would require financial assistance, and the Promised Messiah (as) would not hesitate to help him.

For example, once when Mirza Imamuddin was having trouble selling his horse, the Promised Messiah (as) helped him by sending him to Hazrat Hakim Maulvi Nooruddin (ra).



Mirza Muhammad Baig was another opponent of Ahmadiyyat and the family of the Promised Messiah (as).

When Mirza Muhammad Baig sought employment in Jammu, he approached the Promised Messiah (as) to request a letter of recommendation to Hazrat Hakim Maulvi Nooruddin (ra). The Promised Messiah (as) wrote a letter of recommendation, as a result Mirza Muhammad Baig secured a job.



Once, Mirza Nizamuddin, who was a poor man, walked from Kapurthala to Qadian to visit the Promised Messiah (as). Upon arriving in Qadian, he presented two rupees as a gift to the Promised Messiah (as). A few days later, when Mian Nizamuddin was about to depart, the Promised Messiah (as) gave him seven or eight rupees as a gift upon his departure.
